1. Opening

Agenda – 5 - Discussion on the Reviews of the Draft proposals of the proposed Bridge six (6) Courses of the Department, along with the Draft for framing of the proposed Value-Added Course on "Gandhian Non-violence" [that could be submitted to T.U., eventually] and also the draft documentation of setting up a 'Gandhi Study Centre' at the Department: All the drafts, six (6) Bridge Course Proposals, V.A.C.
