Blessed Basil Moreau (1799-1873)

Basil Moreau the founder of the community of Holy Cross was born in Laigne-en-Belin, a town in Le Mans, France on February 11. 1799. As a priest of the diocese of Le Mans and seminary professor, he established the Association of Holy Cross consisting of two societies one of men (brothers and priests) and the other of women, both having as principal ministries, the education of youth. He was raised to the status of Blessed by the Church on September 15, 2007 for living heroic virtues in life. Through the leadership of Blessed Basil Moreau Holy Cross Contributed mighty for the building up of France that was devastated by the Revolution.

The men and women of Holy Cross maintain educational institutions as well as important social and pastoral ministries in North and South America, Africa and Asia Holy Cross has a strong presence in Northeast India since 1853, the then undivided India. Holy Cross Universities, Colleges and Schools across the world are considered as excellent institutions of learning. Blessed Basil Moreau was an educator with very definite ideas about teaching and learning and about curriculum in terms of both content and methodology. "I Have always been convinced That the fist duty of every teachers is to produce good human beings; society has a greater need for people of values than it has for scholars. Courses Offered: The Program/course leading to an Under Graduate Degree is spread over three years and consists of Six Semesters, each approximately of six months duration.

BA (History)

After the first four (4) years, the department's Honours intake capacity was increased to forty (40) seats, and the B.A. History General programme with a ten (10) seat intake capacity was introduced. As the department is having competent and sufficient numbers of faculty members, enrolment in the history courses is rising. Students in this department are also engaged in an active, student-centred learning process via classroom presentations, projects, group discussions, visits to historical locations, and community outreach programmes, etc. Diversity is one of the Department's most valuable assets. Reflecting the faculty's diverse backgrounds, perspectives, and interests, the department offers a wide range of courses each semester that encompass a variety of cultures, eras, and topics. So, we have total of 50 intake seat capacity for B.A General Course. Each student from English General have to choose three discipline course i.e. Political Science, Sociology/ History, similarly, for History General student i.e. English, Political Science/ Sociology and one foundation paper from 1st semester to 5th semester. Hence forth, in their 6th semester they are offered soft skills such as Indian constitution and planning, Introduction to journalism, Human Rights and Gender studies and compulsory project paper.

B.Sc (Human Physiology)

"The physiology of today is the medicine of tomorrow" - Ernst H. Starling, Physiologist (1926). The Department of Human Physiology started in 2012 as an Elective course and afterwards received permission from Tripura University to offered as an Honours course in 2016. Human physiology is the science of the functioning of human organs and the cells that compose them. As a discipline, it connects science, medicine and health, and investigates the interaction and coordination of molecules, cells, tissues & amp; organs, and how these parts make up the whole body. At the undergraduate level, students are enabled to develop academic competence at the highest level attainable, and are introduced to the forefront of current knowledge in human physiology. The practical modules cover hematology, experimental, biochemical, nutritional, molecular biology & practical modules cover hematology, experimental, biochemical, nutritional, molecular biology microbiology, etc. The lecture modules include neuroscience, regulatory physiology, neuromuscular physiology, perspectives in physiology research, and cell signalling, etc. Interdisciplinary courses and the units involved are biochemistry, microbiology, molecular biology, genetics, immunology, ergonomics, nutrition, statistics and many more. Initially, the department of Human Physiology (Honours) was established with a capacity of twenty (20) students. Presently intake capacity was increased to forty (40) seats. We are also offering a 'Certificate Course on Laboratory Techniques' from December, 2021 onwards to develop job-oriented skills.

Our students are actively participating in various social outreach programmes, internship/ training, field study and study trip, etc. As a whole the dept. is focusing to provide quality education and all-round personality development of our students to make them competence enough for leadership. Our future plans are to start PG course in Human Physiology and also to establish a dedicated 'Molecular Biology & Cell Culture Laboratory'.
