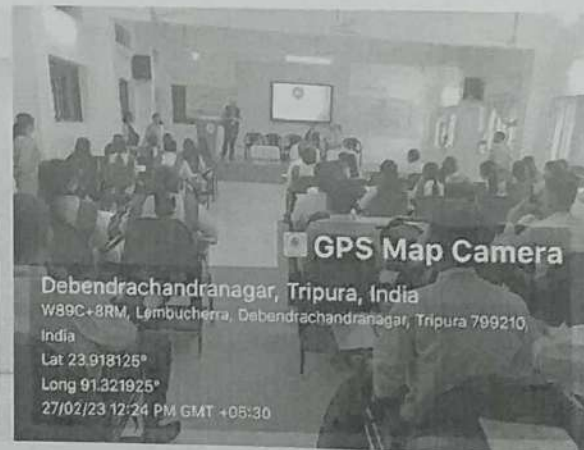
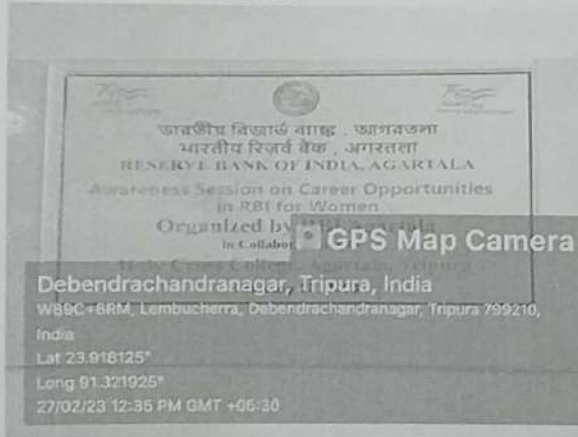
"Awareness on Career Opportunities for Women in RBI and Field Level Financial Literacy Event"




Article III
Dispute Settlement Mechanism

Collaborative activity/ training program on vermicomposting and vermi -culture for students and non-teaching staffs

18/05/2023

On 18th of May the students of the 4th semester Zoology (Major) went to Maya Nursery, Khowai for the field visit and gaining knowledge on practical application of vermitechnology. College bus started from the campus of Holy Cross College, Agartala around 10 am in the morning. The student group was guided by Dr. Subhalaxmi Bhattacharjee and Dr. Rumki Nath Sen.

During the journey the students observed several hilly areas which were being prepared for jhum cultivation. The bus also stopped briefly at Setacchara Tourist Park where they observed wild banana plantations which are endemic to Tripura. The bus arrived at the destination at 11:45 am.

The guide and the owner of the nursery Mr. Bijoy Gope took the students on a tour around his farm and educated them regarding the use of vermicompost for better yields.

The whole nursery was free of chemical fertilizers or pesticides. It was like a place of inhaling fresh air oxygen without having any pollutants or chemicals in it.

At first he guided the students to a green house where new plantations were being grown, like strawberries (*Fragaria ananassa*), mint (*Mentha sp*), coriander (*Coriandrum sativum*), wax gourd (*Benincasa hispida*) etc. After seeing that site they headed towards exploring the other sites and plantations. There they saw dragon fruit (*Hylocereus sp*) plantation by grafting method, 7-8 types of mango (*Mangifera indica*) plantation, variegated guava (*Psidium guajava*) and Indian noni (*Morinda citrifolia*), jackfruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), apple mango plantation (which is most rarely found in Tripura), banana (*Musa sp*)- (C-9) plantation. Mr. Gope explained that each and every plant is being grown by using vermicompost by using the method of “vermicomposting”, not even a single pinch of fertilizer were being used for these plantations over there.

After seeing and observing all the plantations we went to the key place of that nursery – The Vermicomposting Site.

The vermicomposting site consists of three pits and the composting was already done. Sir explained us the composting process and how the earthworms (*Perionyx excavatus*) most suitable for the vermicomposting works.

Mr. Gope explained that for vermicomposting the base of the pit is first prepared by filling it with sand and above the sand a mixture of garden waste, kitchen waste, organic waste, leaves, twigs is filled up. This is remained undisturbed for one month and allowed to decompose. During that one month water is regularly sprinkled in the pit to maintain the moisture of the prepared set up.

Then after one month the earthworms are released into the pit and they start consuming the organic waste. As result within a month or two the organic waste is transformed into vermicompost. Other factors like temperature, humidity, climatic conditions and weather also play an important role.

All the pits are shaded with a cemented ceiling to protect the earthworms from heavy rains.

There was a small channel attached to the pit. Mr. Gope told us that during the process when the pit is filled with excess amount of water that excess amount of water comes out through out that channel and this water is more beneficial and advantageous from vermicompost itself which is used in the plantations. And also the cemented walls made beside pit is a protection for the earthworms from the predators. Example – *Bandicoota sp.*





REPORT ON EDUCATIONAL TRIP TO JAMPUI HILLS

25th – 27th November, 2022

INTRODUCTION:

The Department of Sociology at Holy Cross College organized a three-day educational trip for its students to Jampui Hills in Tripura. The itinerary included visits to Betlingchhip (located in Phuldungsei), the highest peak in Tripura, and Vanghmun, renowned as the cleanest village in the state. The students also had the opportunity to explore the famous Orange gardens of Jampui Hills and immerse themselves in the local culture, gaining knowledge about various cultural aspects. Additionally, the students had gone on a field survey to gather information about the socio-economic conditions of the residents of Phuldungsei. This allowed them to gain a practical understanding of the challenges faced by the local community and the ways in which they cope with them. The field survey proved to be an enriching experience for the students, providing them with hands-on learning and valuable insights into the lives of the local people. During their visit, the students were also captivated by the mesmerizing sunrise and sunset, the eco-friendly surroundings, and the vibrant dance and music performances of the Bru and Mizo communities. The educational trip proved to be a resounding success as it provided the students with a comprehensive understanding of research methodologies to collect data and gain in-depth knowledge about the cultures, traditions, social structures, and languages of the Bru (Reang) and Mizo communities of Jampui Hills. The experience also left an indelible mark on the students, providing them with invaluable and unforgettable memories that cannot be replaced by any other lesson.

OBJECTIVES OF EDUCATION TOUR:

- It aimed to familiarize the students with diverse socio-cultural patterns, value systems, and social practices prevalent in different parts of Tripura.
- It aimed to provide students with a broader understanding of different cultures through purposeful recreation, sightseeing, and discussions in various locations and environments.
- The trip also aimed to provide students with a hands-on learning experience on the application of various research methodologies to collect data, enabling them to develop a comprehensive understanding of the cultures, traditions, social structures, and languages of the local communities of Jampui Hills.

REPORTS FROM THE STUDENT, DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY

On the morning of November 25th, 2022, 31 students from BA(Hons) Sociology and 2 students from BA General who were tired of the monotonous city life and yearning for a break, set out from their college in search of knowledge and an enjoyable experience that went beyond the traditional classroom learning.

Our journey began early in the morning from Agartala by train and arrived at Pencharthal station at 11 am. From there, we were transported in two SUVs and one open roof top pick-up truck to Phuldungsei. The scenic view of the mountains during the journey was breathtaking. As we drove through the jungle, we passed by small bamboo houses on the hillsides, which were both stunning and slightly eerie. We arrived at our destination, MJ Homestay in Phuldungsei, around 3:45 pm. Upon arrival at the homestay, we were promptly served lunch. Following our meal, we were given some leisure time to explore the village of Phuldungsei. Later in the evening, a bonfire atmosphere was arranged by the homestay, where some of us sat together near the fire.

The next day, a group of early risers witnessed a serene sunrise from the rooftop of their homestay between the hours of 4:00am and 6:00am. After taking in the picturesque views and snapping some photos, the group came down to enjoy a delicious breakfast. Following breakfast, each student was given a survey sheet before embarking on a trek to Betlingchhip, the highest peak in Tripura. The view from the watchtower at the peak was breathtaking, offering a stunning panoramic vista of the Jampui hills. Upon returning from the trek, we were split up into four teams, each accompanied by a local guide. We conducted a survey of the local households, using the guides as interpreters to facilitate communication. The survey revealed that the economy of the Jampui hills was largely dependent on orange and arecanut plantation farming, as well as jhum cultivation. The residents of Phuldungsei followed a set of community norms, such as restrictions on chicken farming and keeping pigs in pens. The group also observed that the locals in Phuldungsei woke up early in the morning to engage in jhuming. The major issues in the area were water scarcity and a lack of local transportation options.

After completing our survey, we decided to explore the nearby orange garden and savored the juicy, fresh oranges that it had to offer. We then went back to our homestay, had lunch, rested for an hour, and headed to a local picnic spot called 'VP Picnic Spot.' The sunset at the picnic spot was stunning and had a calming ambiance. We even climbed a hillock that surrounded the picnic spot, which was both exhausting and fun. On top of the hill, we sat in a tourist shed shaped like a circle, where we talked and laughed. While at the picnic spot, some of the students tried on Mizo attire and took pictures. After a busy day, we returned to our

homestay, freshened up, and prepared for a bonfire in the outside compound. A few of us visited the nearby church before joining the rest at the bonfire. We enjoyed playing several games while being entertained with cultural performances by both locals and our group members. The day ended with a delightful dinner alongside the bonfire session.

Before our journey came to an end, we had one final destination on our itinerary - Vanghmun village, known as the cleanest village in Tripura. As we arrived, we were impressed by the village's cleanliness, with several dustbins placed at regular intervals throughout the area. The village had a peaceful atmosphere with well-maintained houses and trimmed bushes. 8. Carry extra cash, snacks and water bottles/flask.

EDUCATIONAL TOUR ARRANGEMENT:

- Our educational tour team to Jampui Hills comprised of thirty-three students and three faculty members.

- It was a trip of 3 days and 2 nights.
- MJ Homestay is a government recognized homestay that offers a variety of services such as accommodation, travel arrangements, picnics, visits to orange gardens, and trekking. They organized an educational trip that included accommodation, food, cultural night with bonfire, sightseeing, trekking to Betlingchip, and transportation from Pencharthal to Phuldengsei, and vice versa, for a cost of Rs 2,500 per student. However, the tour did not cover the expenses of the train journey from Agartala to Pencharthal and back, lunch on the return day, and any snacks. To cover these additional costs, an additional amount of Rs. 500 was collected from each student.
- The institution provided financial assistance by reimbursing 50% of the bill that was generated.






REPORT ON INTRASTATE FIELD TRIP TO NAGICHERA

Held On 21/06/2022

ORGANISED BY

Department Of Botany, Holy Cross College, Agartala

Botanical studies of a local region not only are of a didactic value, but they are also the region they live in. Going outdoors, visiting nearby and farther surroundings (on their way from home to institute, on playgrounds, sightseeing sites, etc.), students, together with their teachers, can observe the principal properties, record and collect plants or analyze and describe plant communities and vegetation of the given region.

The tour was held on 21st June in Horticulture research Complex (HRC), near Nagicherra. All the faculties of the Department of Botany and lab technician were accompanied by the students. There was an interaction with the Director of HRC, Dr. Rajib Ghosh, who presented a short presentation where he discussed the following topics: 1. Research on Mushrooms and production of spawns. 2. Germplasm of different jhum vegetations. 3. Evaluation of commercial varieties of vegetables. 4. Seed production program. 5. Staggering pineapple. 6. Tissue culture activity. 7. Human resource development. At the end of the conference, students and teachers went to the mushroom culture center, visited tissue culture and moved back to the backyard of the culture medium room to visit the garden under the guidance of Rajasree Chacraborty, Agriculture Officer. Then after moving to another place a HRC staff demonstrated the process of grafting and then all went on a tour to the vegetation ground of HRC with another staff, where there were many plant species.

Field study is an essential part of Botany as plants are best studied in their natural habitat. The students get exposed to the plant kingdom. The students get practical knowledge of different species of plants like herbs, shrubs, climbers, and trees. Field trips provide authentic, hands-on experimental learning opportunities where we can connect what we are learning in the classroom to a real-world context. Thus, the trip not only provided us with knowledge but also widened our thoughts, explores our knowledge, and also made our learning more interesting.

National Deworming Campaign

Date: 14th September, 2022

Worms in children interfere with nutrient uptake, and can contribute to anaemia, malnourishment, and impaired mental and physical development. To combat this issue, in 2015 the Government of India launched the fixed-day Anganwadi and school and college-based National Deworming Day to deworm all children and teens aged 1-19 years. As a part of this initiative the Holy Cross College, Jubatara under the block Bamutia had also organize a campaign namely as "Mukhyamantri Sustho Shaishob Sustho Kaishore Abhiyan-3.0 (National Deworming Day)" on 14th September 2022. Faculties of Human Physiology creates an awareness among the students by providing the crucial information's about the symptoms and the health complications of worms before the distribution of the medicines. Around 300 students (adolescent boys and girls) along with the Human Physiology students had actively participated in that campaign. Out of that around 160 girls and 140 boys were administered with the tablet commonly called "Albendazole". It is an anthelmintic or anti-worm medicine. Generally used as an effective aid for the treatment of tapeworm, flatworm or other types of nematodes found in our body. At the same time Iron and Folic acid tablets also provided to all the students as a part of this campaign. This Albendazole and Iron and Folic acid tablets for distribution are provided by Primary Health Center of Mohanpur.

These worms are infecting our intestine and the major issues are as such: -consumption of contaminated water, contact with the contaminated fecal matter, poor hygiene and lack of proper sanitation. It is can be concluded that Deworming and its procedures should be continued on our environment in a huge manner because it has a positive impact on the environment which helps to cure many other diseases. Distribution of Tablets among the students of Holy Cross College by Faculties of Department of Human Physiology.

NATIONAL DEWORMING CAMPAIGN

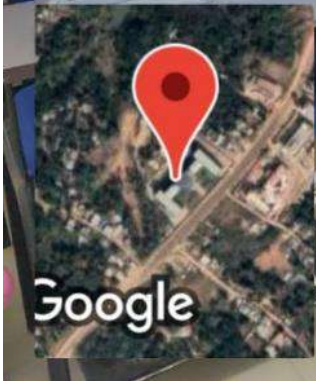

The National Deworming Campaign is an initiative of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India to make child in the country worm free. In India, about 241 million children between the ages of 1-14 years are at a risk of parasitic intestinal worms, commonly known as Soil-transmitted Helminths (STH). STH can lead to anemia, malnutrition etc. To combat this serious issue, in 2015, the Govt. of India launched National Deworming Day in anganwadi centres, schools and colleges to deworm all children and teens between aged 1-19 years. Deworming improves immunity in children as well as adults, thereby protecting them from chronic illnesses caused by worms. As a part of this initiative, Department of Human Physiology, Holy Cross College, Agartala under the block Bamutia had also organized 'National Deworming Campaign' under the banner "Mukhyamantri Sushto Shaishob Sustho Kaishore Abhiyan 4.0" on 31st march, 2023. Faculties of Human Physiology Department created an awareness program among the students providing crucial information about the symptoms and different health complications of worms before distributing the medicines. Around 97 students participated among which there were 67 girls and 30 boys of under 19 years of age. Medicines distributed among them were "Albendazole tablets, Iron and Folic acid tablets" which were provided by Primary Health Centre of Mohanpur. Albendazole is an anthelmintic or anti-worm medicine which is generally used as an effective aid for the treatment of different kinds of worms in human body. The iron and folic acid tablets are an iron supplement used to prevent low blood levels of iron such as those caused by anemia. Students were also advised about the dosage of taking these medicines. Periodic large-scale distribution of anthelmintics is the most-effective intervention against these parasites.
