

With a focus on a few indigenous tribes in Tripura, our study aims to record and examine the brewing processes, ingredients, and cultural importance of tribal beers produced there.

### **Objectives:**

1. To identify and document the types of tribal beers consumed in Tripura and their respective brewing techniques.
2. To examine the cultural relevance of tribal beers and their function in social and ritual contexts among a few indigenous tribes in Tripura.
