Organizational visits

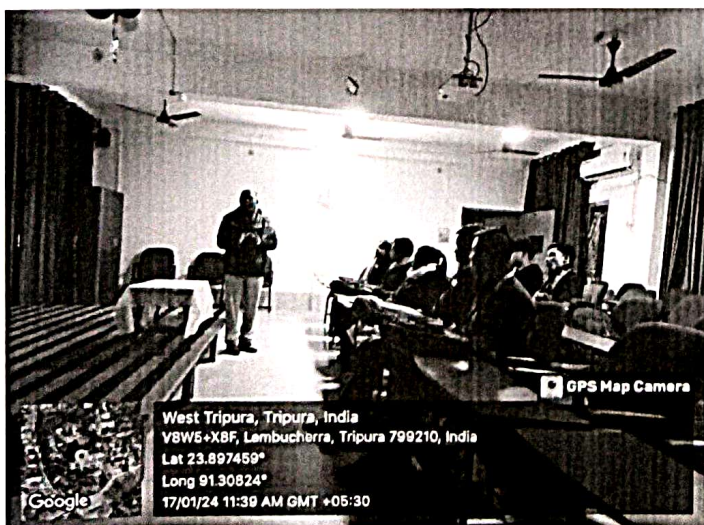
Association for Social and Human Advancement (ASHA)
