Report on Plantation Program and Power point Presentation Competition on the occasion of National Science Day, 2024 Organized by Zoology Department, Holy Cross College, Agartala in collaboration with College Biotech Club, sponsored by Directorate of Biotechnology, Govt. of Tripura, held on 28th February 2024.

The theme for National Science 2024 was focused on 'Indigenous Technologies for Viksit Bharat'. It highlights on promoting scientific skills and innovations and emphasizes the use of technologies developed in India. Keeping this in view, Zoology Department of Holy Cross, Agartala in collaboration with College Biotech Club, sponsored by Directorate of Biotechnology, Govt. of Tripura, celebrated the National Science Day through popular talk, quiz, power point presentation competition and plantation program. The aim of these competitions was to raise awareness among students about the contribution of great Indian Biologist in the scientific world. Plantation program was arranged to promote a sense of responsibility towards environment among students.

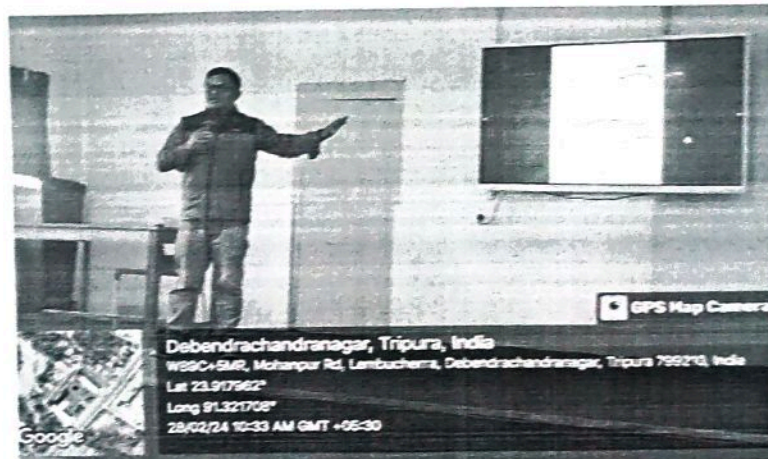
The program started at 10 am on 28th February 2024. The venue of the program was Room No. G-8. of Holy Cross College, Agartala. The program was graced by the presence of respected Principal of HCC, Dr. Fr. Benny K. John, CSC and respected IQAC coordinator, DR. Sushobhan Sengupta, all the faculty members of the Departments of Zoology, Human Physiology and Botany along with the students. Fifty students participated in the Power point Presentation Competition. Total number of attendees in the Program was recorded to be sixty five.

The program started with the inaugural address by Principal, HCC, Dr. Fr. Benny K. John who pointed out the importance of harnessing the power of science for the greater good of

society and the planet. He also mentioned that in an era marked by unprecedented challenges such as climate change, environmental degradation etc., it is imperative that we turn to science and innovation to find sustainable solutions to these pressing issues. Dr. Sushobhan Sengupta, IQAC coordinator, HCC shared his valuable ideas to the students on how to make power points more attractive and presentable. Dr. Parichita Ray Choudhury, Asst. Professor, Zoology Dept. & the Principal Investigator of the Project, 'Establishment of Butterfly Park in HCC Campus' then delivered a popular talk on the common butterflies of the Butterfly Park of HCC Campus & a brief idea about different butterfly families.'. She also highlighted the significance of National Science Day and mentioned how the discovery of Raman Effect brought recognition to Indian science on global stage and paved the way for numerous ground breaking advancements in various scientific fields. In her popular talk, she mentioned about the life and contributions of the 'butterfly men' of India- Isaac David Kehimkar and Dr. Krushnamegh Kunte who did pioneering work in the field of butterfly research. She also, highlighted the achievements of Roshan Upadhaya, the butterfly man of Arunachal Pradesh. A quiz competition was organized based on the popular talk delivered in which students spontaneously participated and won prizes for giving the correct answers.

The Power point Presentation competition was based on the theme, 'Life and Contribution of Great Indian Biologists.' Fifty students of 1st Semester of Departments of Zoology, Human Physiology, Botany and Geography of HCC enthusiastically participated in the competition. They highlighted the major life events, activities and achievements of great Indian Biologists such as Har Govind Khorana, Acharya Jagadish Chandra Bose, Salim Ali and others. The judges for the competition were Dr. Sandip Roy Sarkar from Human Physiology Department, Dr. Shubhalaxmi Bhattacharjee, Department of Zoology, Dr. Somnath Kar and Dr. Debasree Lodh of Botany Department. The third event of the day was plantation program. It was organized in the site of Butterfly Park in the HCC campus. Several preferred host plants and plants that serve as nectar for butterflies were selected for the plantation. Students actively participated in the program and planted the saplings in the butterfly park. The program ended with the vote of thanks by Dr. Rumki Nath Sen, HOD of Zoology Department and also, the Co PI. of 'Establishment of Butterfly Park in HCC Campus' Project. The winners of the competition were awarded with medals and certificates. Each of the participants was provided with participation certificate and refreshments.

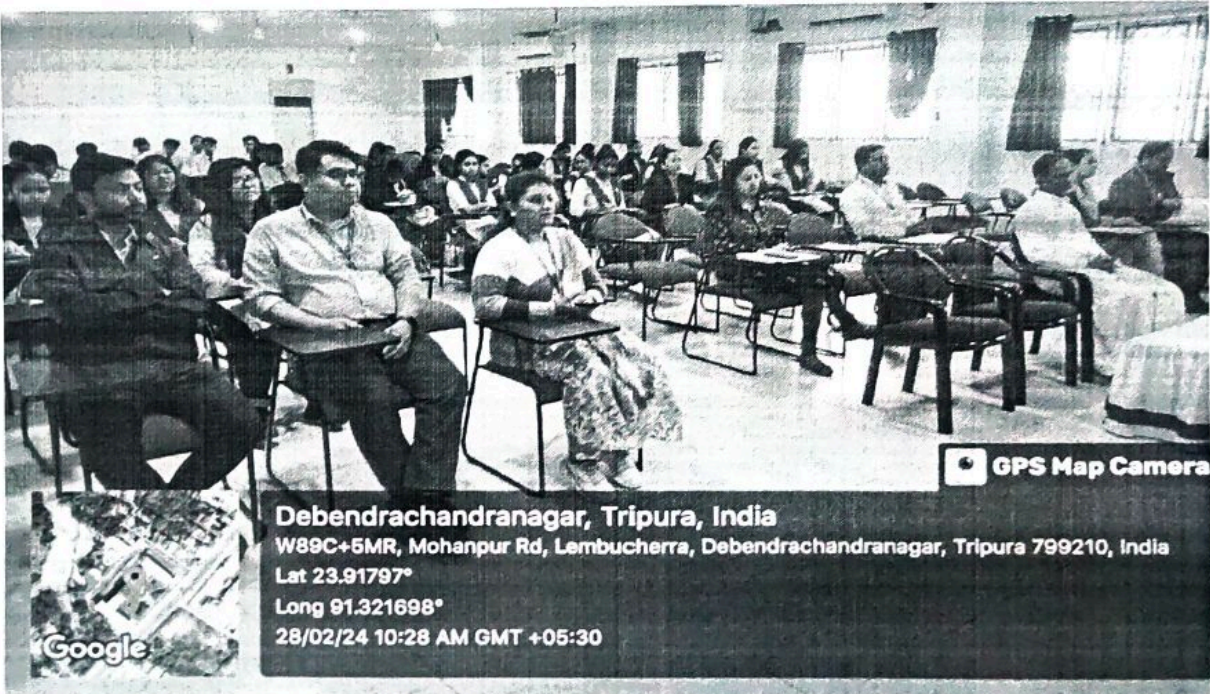
