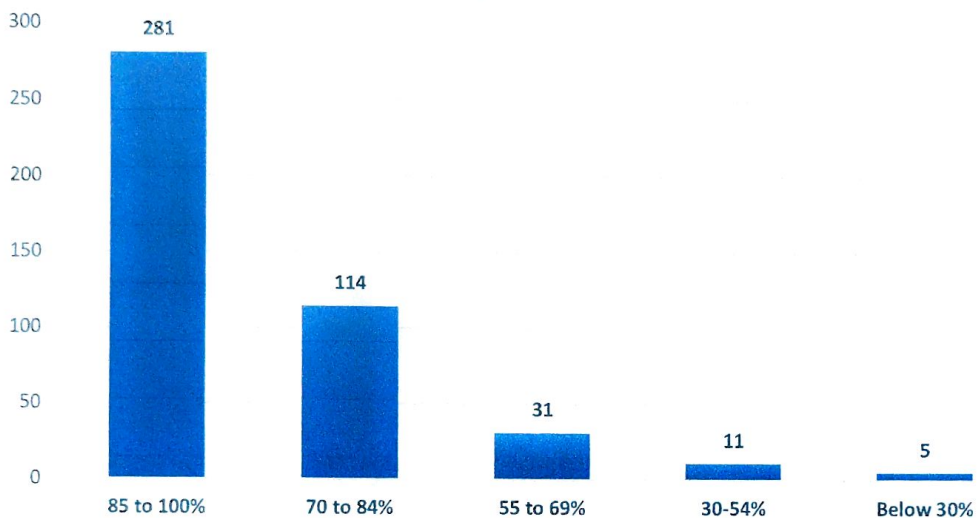

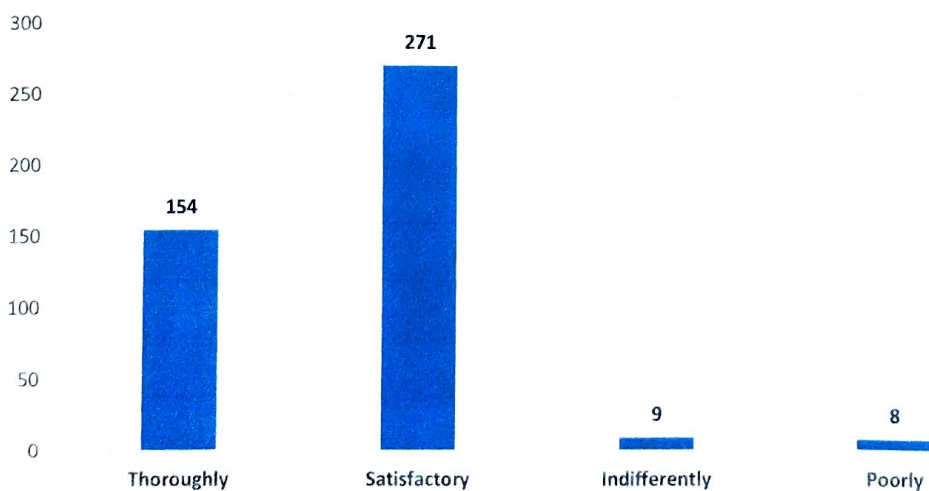

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

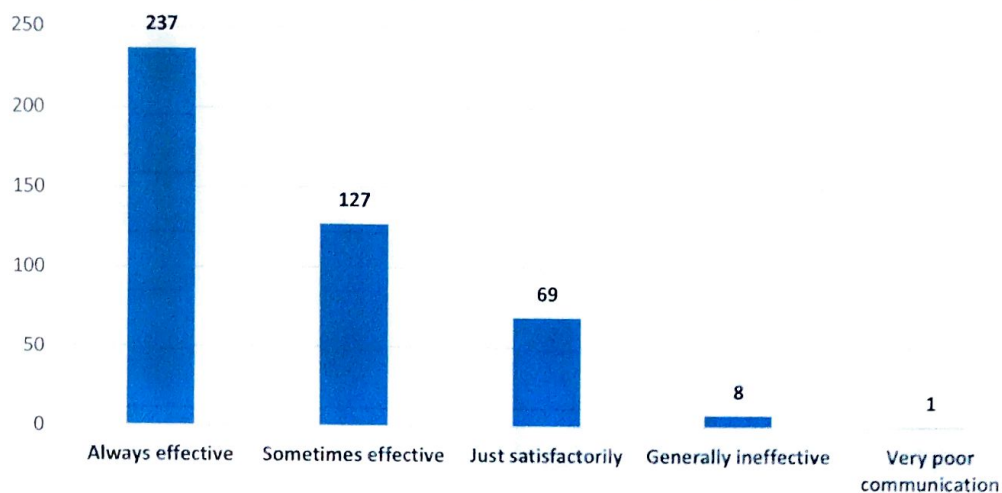


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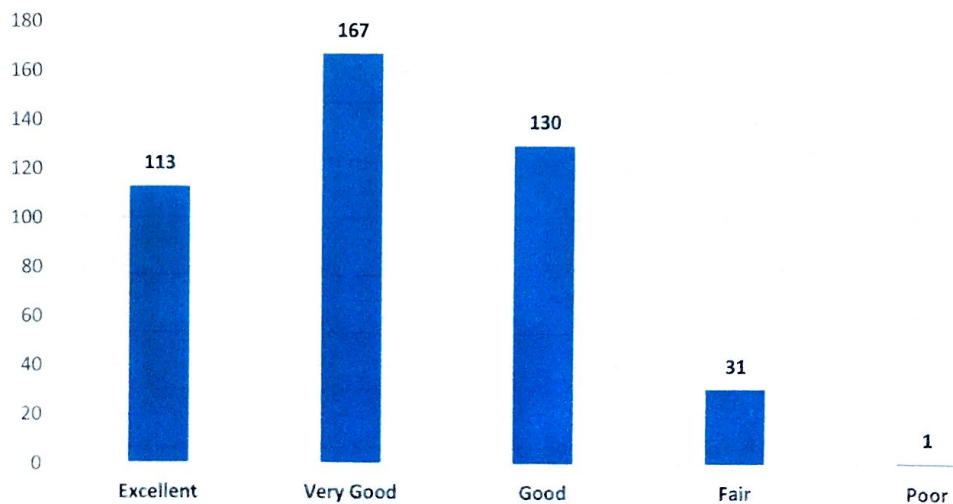

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

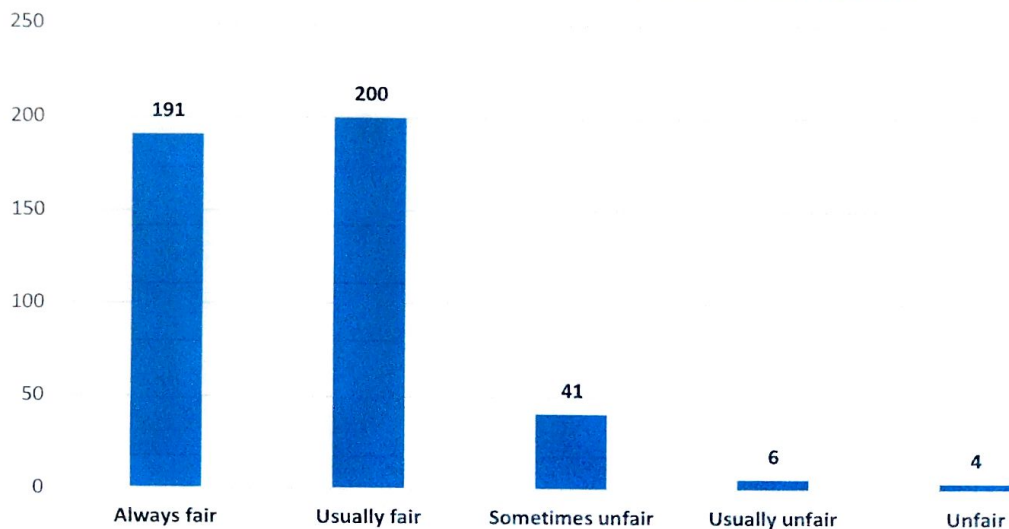


4. The teachers approach to teaching can be best described as -

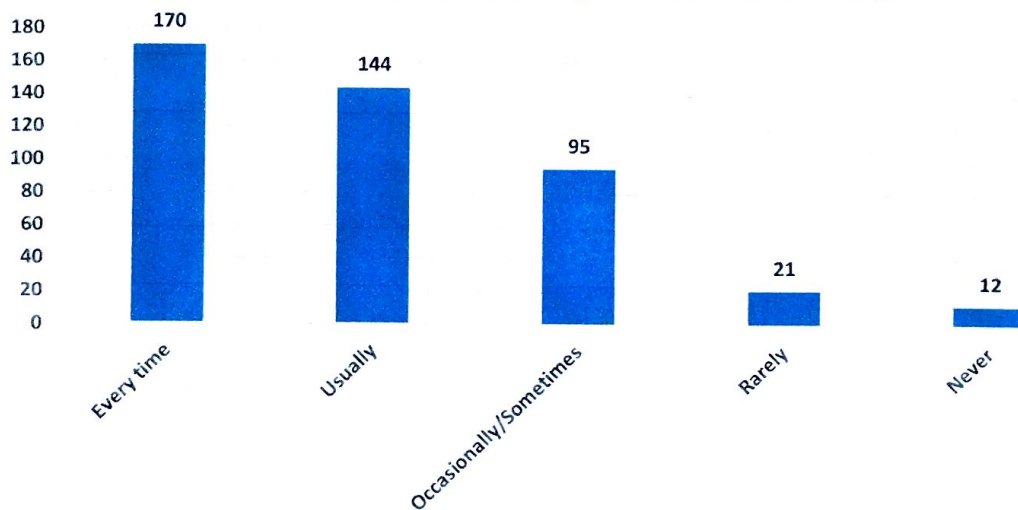

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers

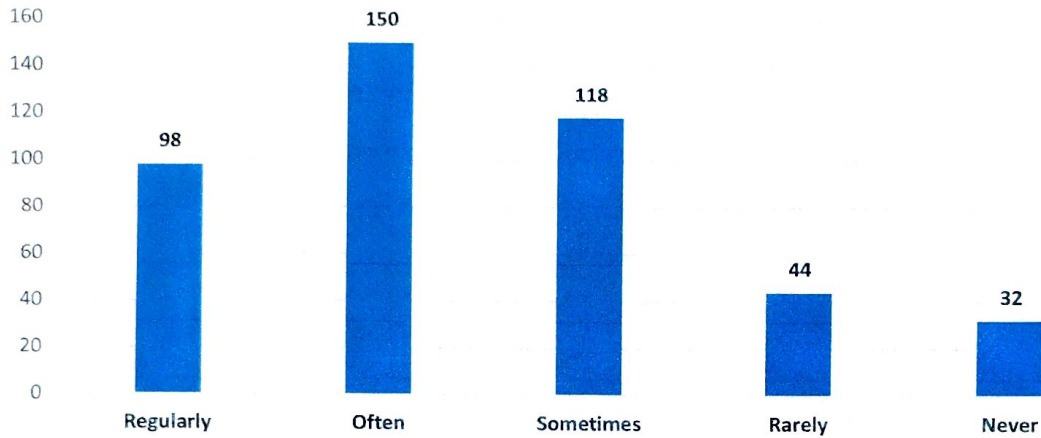


6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

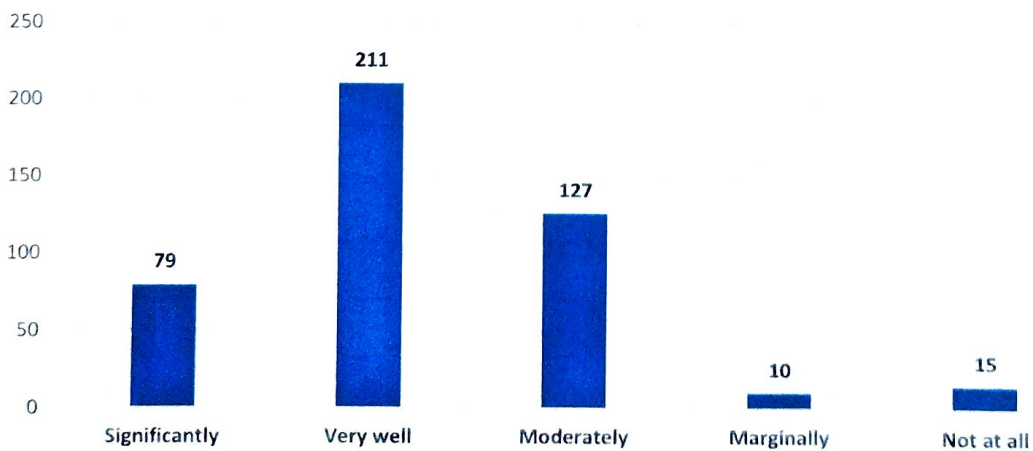

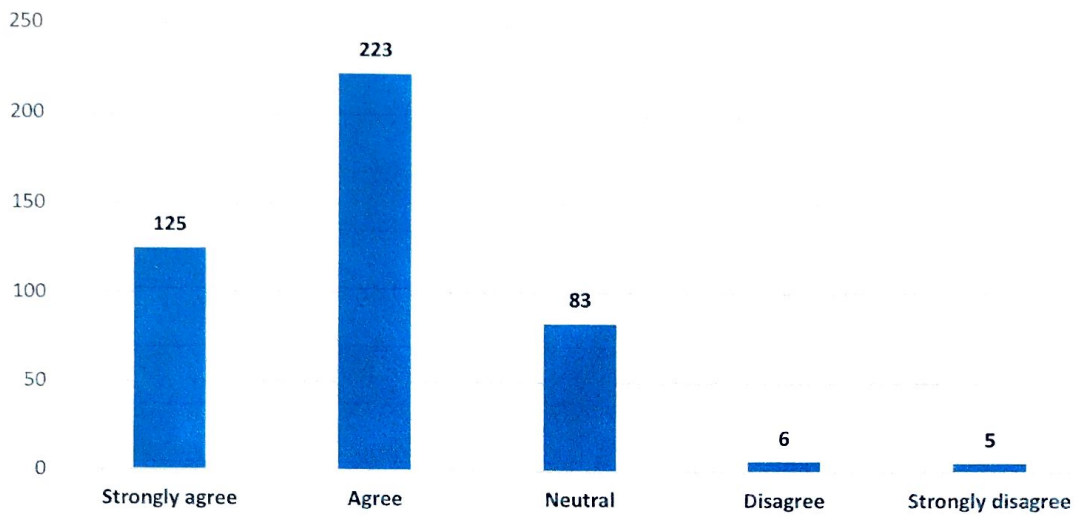


8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

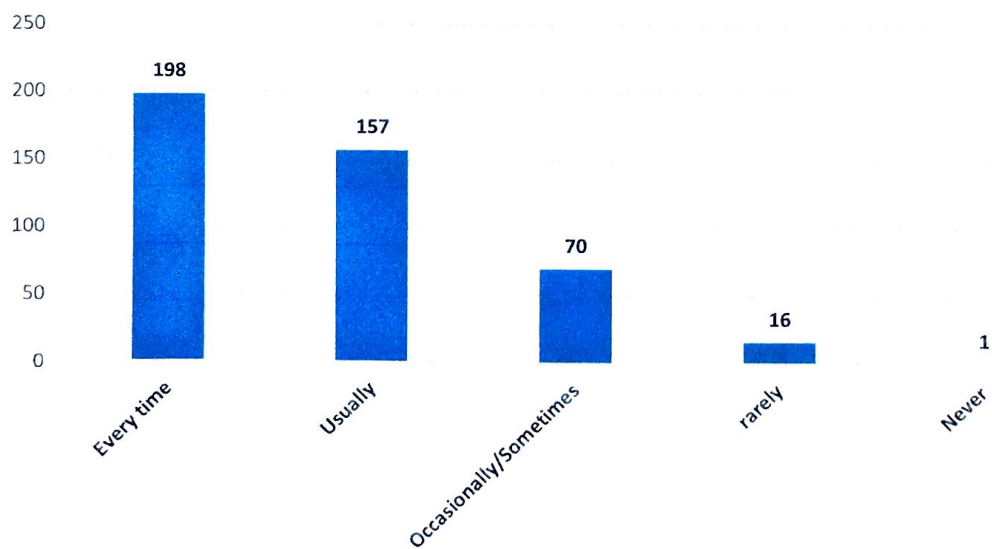

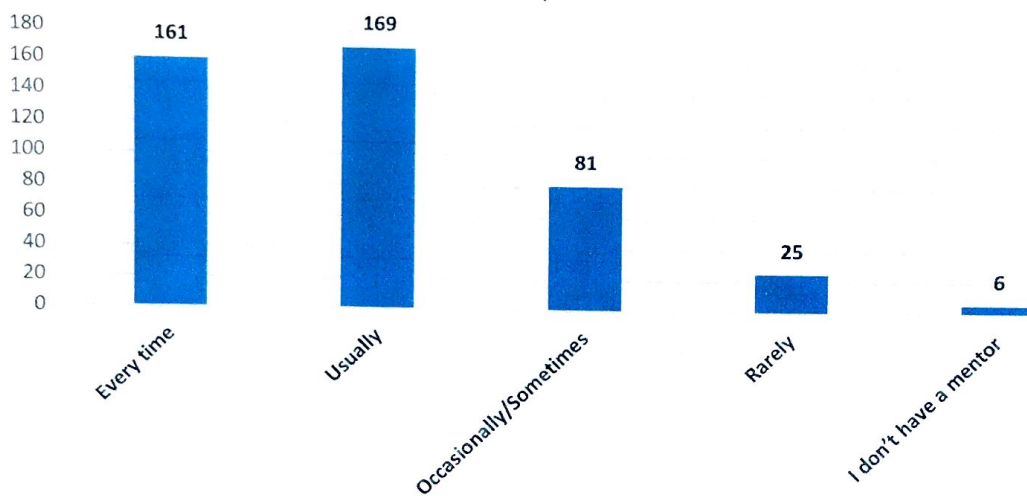


10.Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

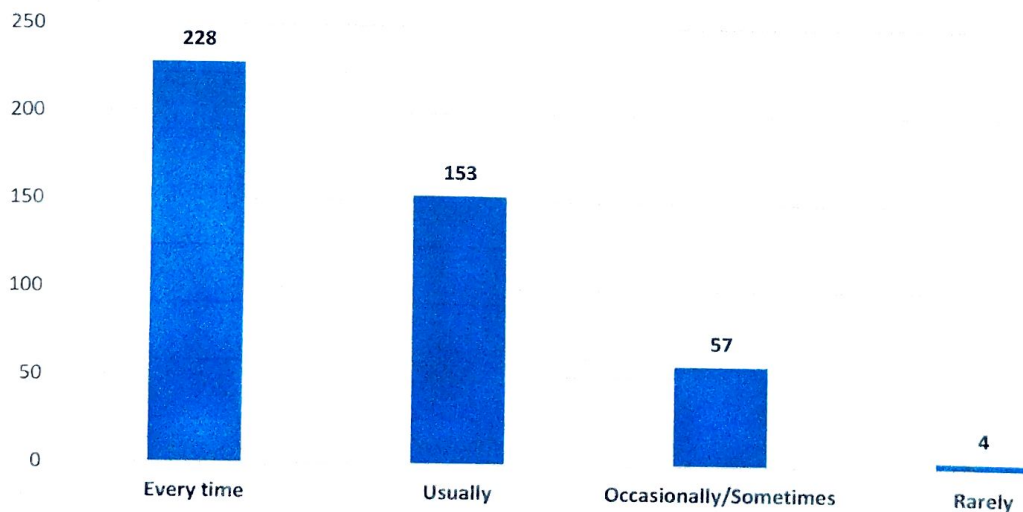

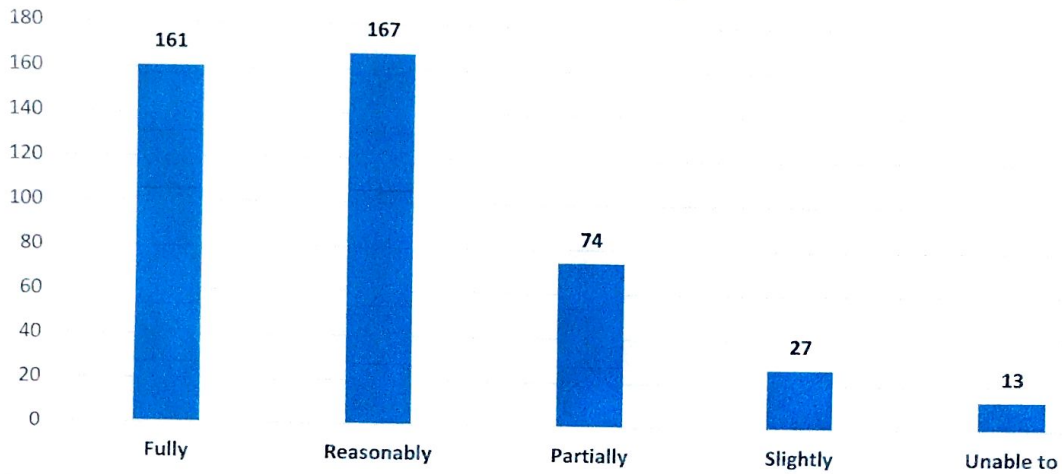


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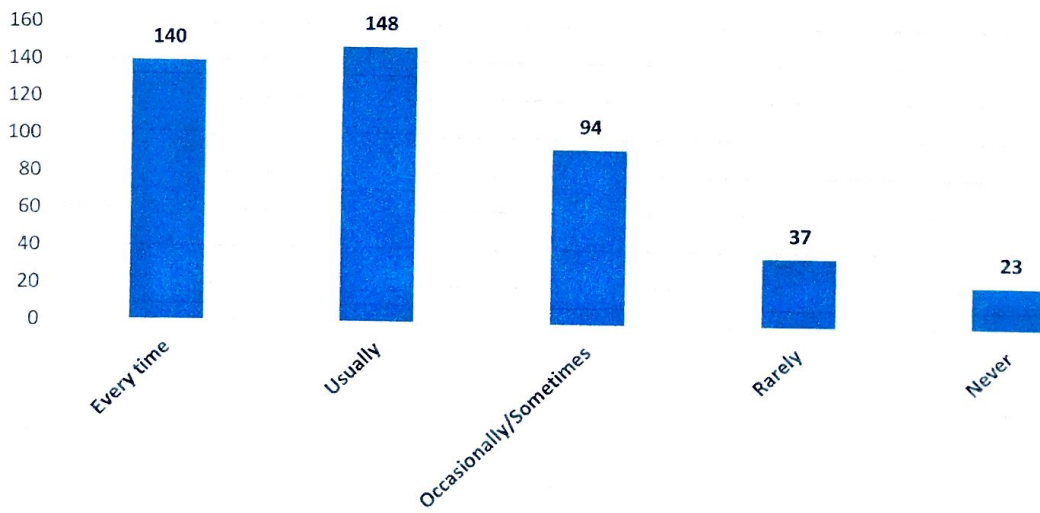

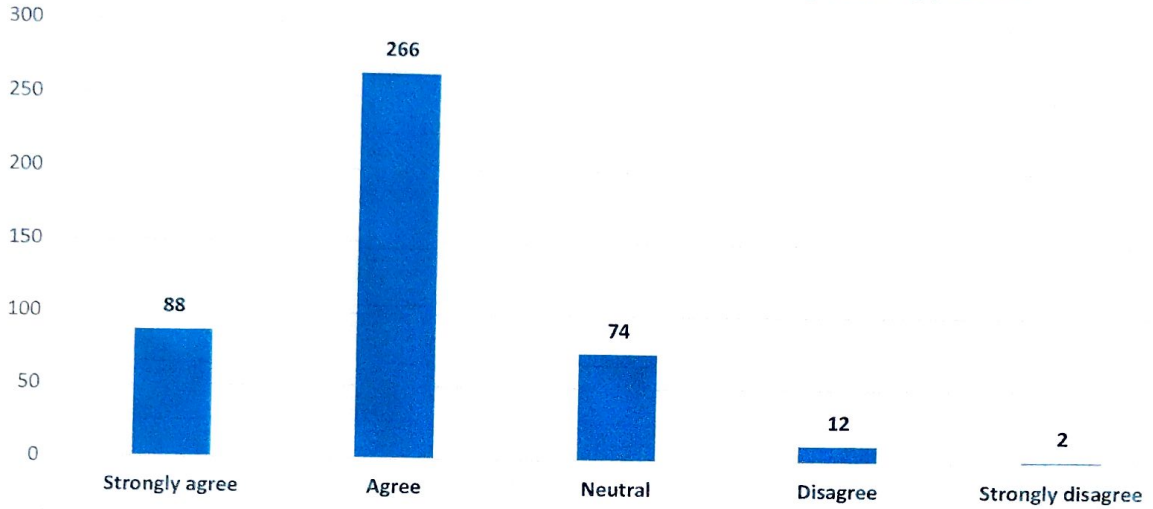


14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

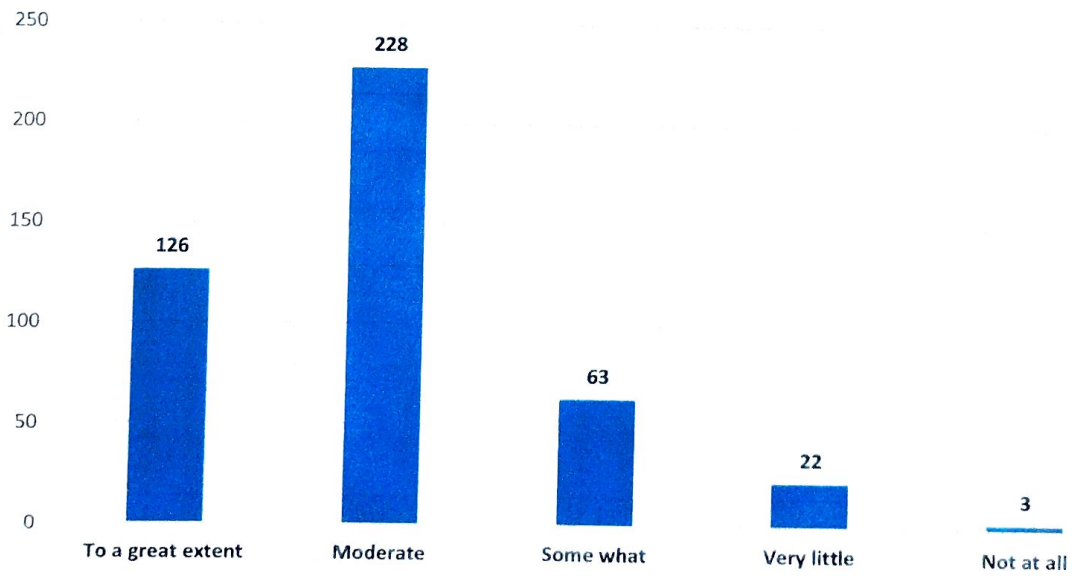

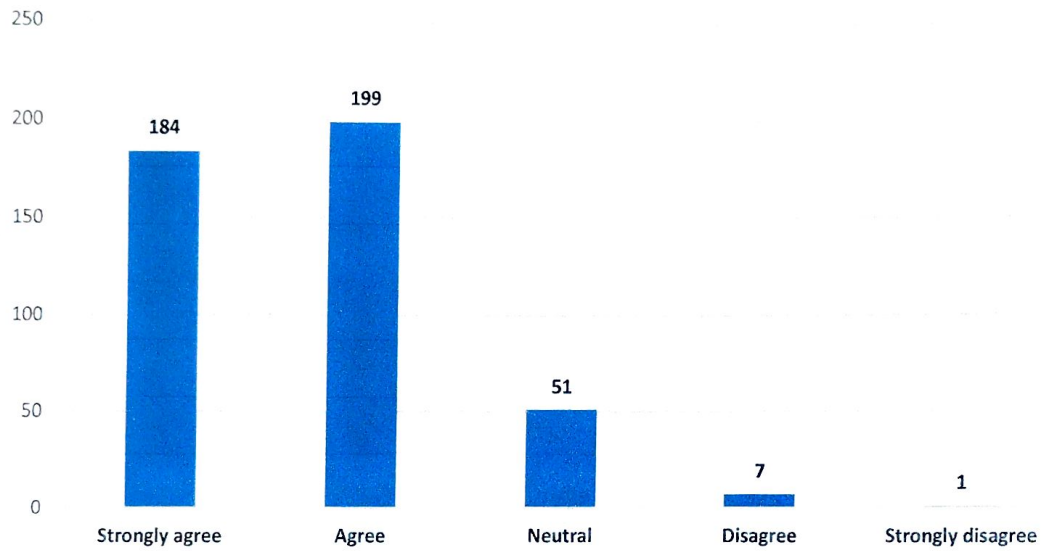


16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

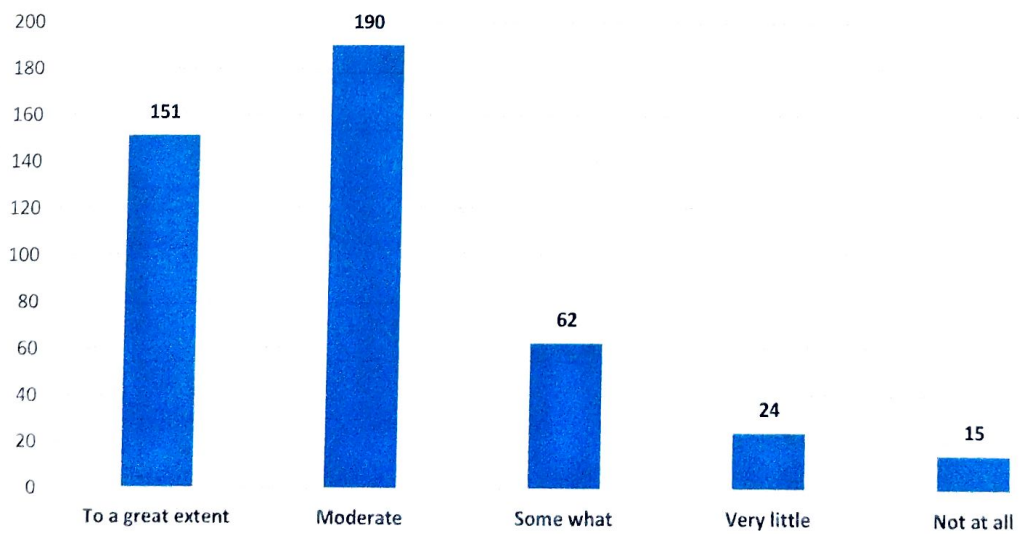

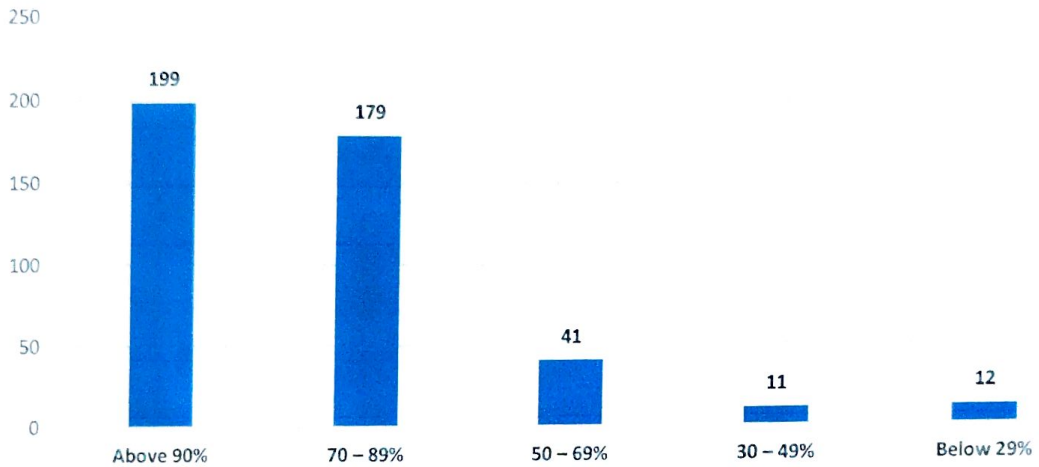


18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

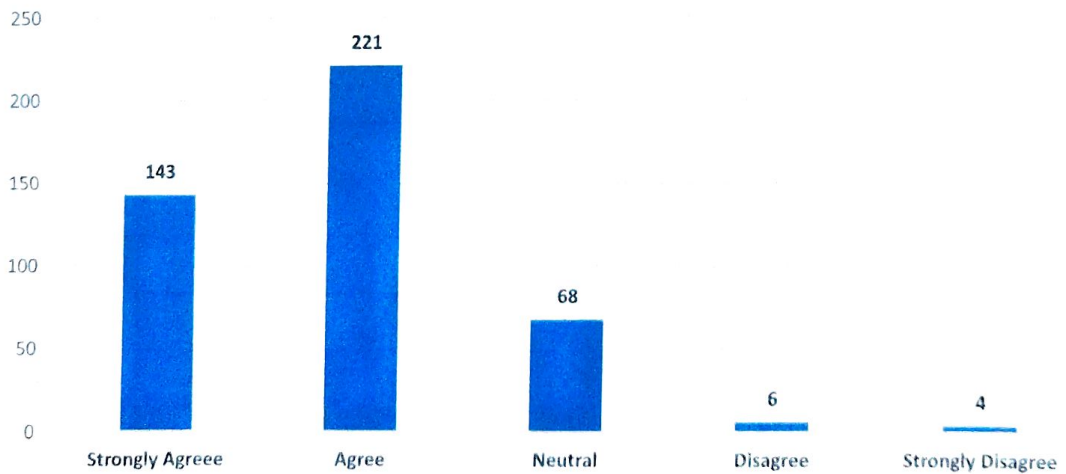

2.7 – Students Satisfaction Survey
Report

The Students Satisfaction Survey of IQAC, 2023 – 2024 of Holy Cross College, Agartala was conducted in the month of August, 2024 and a total number of 442 students of 3rd and 5th Semesters enrolled in the college, participated in it. The Questionnaire of this Survey contained 20 number of questions and covered areas like Teaching, Learning and Evaluation Process. Out of 442 students, 407 students participated for the first time whereas 35 students took part earlier in this type of Survey. In the perspective of gender, 174 Male Students and 266 Female Students joined the survey. Two Students preferred not to disclose their gender identity. Category wise from the UR Category 133 students, from ST Category 241 Students, from the SC Category 23 Students, from the OBC Category 39 Students and 6 from Other Categories were engaged in the Survey. In terms of Course distribution, from the Batchelor of Arts Course 244 students, from B.Sc 122 Students, from B.Ed. 32 Students, from the Batchelor of Business Administration Course 25 Students, Bachelor of Commerce 16 Students, from Post Graduate Courses 3 Students took part in this Survey.

This survey envisages that **as an institution, Holy Cross college holds a very high position.**

The **teachers** of this institution **maintain a very superior quality.** According to the survey, teachers cover almost the **entire syllabus** (70 to 100% covered stated by 395 students), they remain well prepared for their classes (satisfactory to thoroughly was the answer of 395 students), they are effective communicator (364 students said so), 70 – 100% of the teachers use ICT tools and multimedia while teaching (378 students agreed to that).

The **teaching and mentoring process** in this institution is well enough to facilitate all round development of the students (more than half of the students stated so). The teachers almost regularly inform students about their expected competencies, COs and Pos (355 students stated usually to every time). Regularity is also maintained while providing necessary feedback with an assigned task as stated by 330 students.

As for the **teaching methods** applied, the teachers of this institution always deliver concepts with examples and application as opined by more than half of the students. They also identify students' weaknesses to provide solutions to overcome those, as was the opinion of more than half of the students. Not only that, the teachers highly satisfactorily identify students' strength and encourage them providing right level of challenges (328 students are of this opinion).

Institution's **Evaluation system**, is on the other hand, **Highly Fair** (391 students possess this opinion). Students' performance in assignments discussed almost always (170 said every time to usually by 144 students).

According to the maximum number of students, this **Institution** takes active interest in promoting Internship programme, student Exchange programme, and create field visit opportunities for the students almost regularly (368 students are almost of same opinion).

This **institutions effort** is highly satisfactory to engage students in the **monitoring, review** and in **continuous quality improvement of teaching-learning process** (354 students agreed to that). The institutions/teachers' performance is **highly satisfactory** when it comes to use of **student centric methods.**

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The teachers in this institution are enthusiastic enough in the matter of encouraging students to participate in extracurricular activities (383 students agreed to that).

Not only that this **institution and its teachers** are **particularly effective** to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make the students ready for the world of work (341 students gave opinion for moderate to a great extent).

And the **overall teaching-learning process** in this **institution** is **VERY GOOD** according to the judgement given by 364 students.
