MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) For Academic Cooperation

Between

Bhavan's Tripura Teacher Training College(BTTTC) Anandanagar, Agartala, Tripura

&

Holy Cross College (HCC) Jubatara, Agartala, Tripura In accordance with the principles of friendship, equality and mutual academic benefit, to strengthen friendship ties and to further the mutual understanding between Bhavan's Tripura Teacher Training College (herein after referred as BTTTC), Anandanagar, Agartala, West Tripura and Holy Cross College (herein after referred as HCC), Jubatara, Agartala, Tripura agrees for institutional collaboration in education and other activities through academic cooperation and for this they are of one accord in entering this MoU.

Both "BTTTC" and "HCC" together and collectively for the purposes of the MoU be referred to as "Parties or Institutions" and individually as "Party or Institution."

Whereas,

BTTTC is a co-educational teacher education institute (TEI) established in 2015 under the tutelage of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, a centre in which our ancient learning and modern intellectual aspirations combine to create a new spirit, a new literature and a new culture. The college is set up by Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, Agartala Kendra with the active support of the Government of Tripura with an objective of offering teacher education programmes. BTTTC is offering B.Ed and D.El.Ed programmes which are recognized by National Council for Teacher education (NCTE). The institution is affiliated to Tripura University (A Central University) for two-year B.Ed and that to SCERT Tripura for two-year D.El.Ed programme in regular mode. The motto of the institution is to empower students to challenge conservative thinking in pursuit of creative ideas that develop them into a better human being along with professional, moral and social competencies. BTTTC is committed to develop a holistic teacher with major focus on quality, equity, inclusiveness and excellence through research, innovation, extension and training to enrich the school education.

Whereas,

HCC, Agartala is a private English medium co-educational post-graduate institution of higher learning, founded, animated and enlivened by the Congregation of Holy Cross, a community of scholarship and faith, anchored by a belief in the inherent dignity of each person. This institution provides opportunities of scholarship for academically qualified graduates primarily for the state of Tripura and also from the rest of India and its neighbouring Nations. Its prime focus is to provide 'holistic education', educating the hearts and the minds of the young. The courses offered by the institution are B.A., B.Sc., B.Com, BBA, (Teacher Education) B.Ed along with PG courses in the disciplines of Arts and Management. The college has been accredited with grade A+ by NAAC, in its second cycle of accreditation in the year 2023.

PREAMBLE

Following communications between <u>BTTTC</u> and <u>IICC</u> a formal Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective for a period of five (5) years from the date it has been signed by both the parties, with a desire to initiate certain cooperative programs beneficial to the respective educational institutions and to promote the development of academics, research, training activities and other educational programs of mutual interests by giving more emphasis on teacher education programs.

AGREEMENT

In contemplation of the relationship to be established and for consideration, both parties agree as follows:

- 1. This agreement supplants the previous agreements between the two parties. If any subsequent discussions, agreements and understandings, whether verbal or in writing, are subsumed by this agreement. Palpable modification requires a fresh written agreement reached by both parties.
- 2. This agreement is not considered to be a contract creating legal and financial obligations between <u>BTTTC</u> and <u>HCC</u>. The primary objective of this agreement is to promote interaction and collaboration between faculty members, staff and students of the two institutions through visits, study programs, research activities and exchange programs on a reciprocal basis.
- 3. It is agreed that **<u>BTTTC</u>** and <u>HCC</u> will work together to promote the following:
 - a. Research Collaboration: Faculty/researchers/students of <u>BTTTC</u> and <u>HCC</u> can collaborate in future research activities that either involve working cooperatively with partner institutions and/or cover a research topic with an international component.
 - b. Student exchanges: Students can be given an opportunity to travel among the parties to participate in activities/events that will enhance their knowledge. Activities include, but are not limited to, a semester, study with credit transfer, dual specialization, taking short term certificate courses, etc. (as per the provision/norms laid down by the parent University and other regulatory bodies).
 - c. Faculty exchanges: Faculty members of <u>BTTTC</u> and <u>HCC</u> can participate in activities that can enhance their knowledge and also to foster relations between the parties. Activities include, but are not limited to, delivering lectures, teaching a course, taking a sabbatical, acquiring skills for institutional governance and developing collaborative research etc.
 - d. **Promotion of integrated curriculum for related studies:** The parties can look at integrating an international-intercultural dimension into their teaching, research, and service functions of the institution which would enable the students to acquire a better understanding on a global perspective.

- e. Faculty Development Programme (FDP)/Workshops/Seminar/Conferences: Both parties can organize FDP/workshops/seminars/conferences, in collaboration with one another, such that faculty members from either institution can be invited as speaker/expert/resource person in these programme/activities. Similarly, faculty members of both the institutions can participate in these programmes.
- f. Collaboration in the exchange of information relating to their activities in teaching and research in fields of mutual interests; sharing of e-content between the parties; access to library and repository services, other resource mobilization, if possible.
- g. Conducting cultural projects, study tours, as mutually agreed upon in writing between <u>BTTTC</u> and <u>HCC</u> prior to commencement of these activities.
- 4. This agreement is incorporated into and will provide the foundation and framework for the particular projects developed by academic and administrative units from the two institutions and embodied in subsequent agreements. As specific projects are developed, memoranda of agreements will be created and signed by both parties regarding the specific terms of those projects.
- 5. This agreement, when executed by the parties, shall continue for a period of five (5) years from the date it has been signed by both parties. Upon written agreement by both parties, this may be renewed for an additional period of time with notification at least six (6) months before expiration of the agreement. Either party may terminate the agreement with six (6) months written notice of intent to terminate. (However, specific commitments made prior to such intimation shall be honoured by both the parties including ensuring that any student at that time participating in any programme is able to complete the term of the assignment and be assessed for it.)
- 6. Neither party is obligated to expend any resources in connection with this agreement. Each party is responsible for the resources necessary to perform its obligations under this agreement. No implementation of any portion of this agreement or commencement of any specific projects may be initiated prior to the written assurance of adequate budgetary resources. <u>BTTTC</u> and <u>HCC</u> may jointly or individually seek funding and other support from third parties to support activities under this agreement.
- 7. This agreement shall not be construed to create a relationship of partners, brokers, employees, servants, joint ventures or agents as between the parties. The parties to this agreement are acting as independent participants. In the event that the parties decide to engage in activities which involve employment, separate agreements addressing those issues will be required.
- 8. The parties shall cooperate mutually to resolve any dispute or misunderstanding by collaboration and discussion within two (2) months, if the dispute or misunderstanding could not be resolved during the said time-frame then the agreement may be terminated by publishing a notice by any one of the parties.
- 9. This agreement shall be considered in effect upon the signatures of all required representatives of each institution.

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING [hereinafter MOU] is made and entered into on Friday, 03.01.2020 between *Sophia Girls' College (Autonomous), Ajmer, Rajasthan (hereinafter SGC),* on the ONE PART and *Holy Cross College, Agartala (hereinafter HCC),* on the OTHER PART (who for the purpose of this MOU are hereinafter individually referred to as 'PARTY' and collectively referred to as the 'PARTIES').

The PARTIES, having discussed the fields of common research interests and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into a long-term collaboration in the areas of education, training and research.

WHERE AS Sophia Girls' College (Autonomous), Ajmer (Rajasthan) established in 1959 is a premier education Institution of higher learning in Rajasthan having U.G. & P.G. Programs in Arts, Science, Commerce, Management, Computer Science and Library and Information Science along with Ph.D. Program in various disciplines. The College has been reaccredited Grade 'A'+ by NAAC Bangalore, and is involved in the dissemination of knowledge, research and extension.

And WHEREAS *Holy Cross College, Agartala* an institution of Higher Learning having UG and PG courses and is involved in research, education, training and extension.

AND HENCE it has been considered expedient to agree in writing to participate jointly in undertaking students and research projects as per the expertise and logistics available with the PARTIES.

Article 1. Objectives

Article 3. Forms of Cooperation

3.1 Joint research projects

3.2 Academic projects/ programmes

- 3.3 Seminars and lectures on topics of mutual interest and relevance
- 3.4 Public outreach

Article 4. Exchange of Information and Research Samples

4.1 The term "information" includes scientific or technical data, results and/or methods of investigation, and other information intended to be provided, exchanged or arising under the objectives identified under Article 1. The PARTIES shall take all measures to protect the secrecy and avoid disclosure and unauthorized use of the information which is confidential and outside the public domain.

4.2 Samples exchanged between the PARTIES shall not be transferred to any third party for research and commercial purposes and that the unutilized portions of such samples must be sent back to the concerned coordinators identified under Article 6.1.

Article 5. Publications and Intellectual Property Rights

5.1 Any research publications and intellectual property rights arising out of the students- and joint research projects shall be jointly published and, when patented, will be jointly and equally owned by SGC and HCC

5.2 The procedural formalities for securing and maintaining the intellectual property rights shall be the responsibility of both SGC / HCC and the expenditure incurred thereof shall be borne jointly and equally by them.

5.3 The upfront fee and royalty accrued from licensing of any intellectual property arising from this collaboration to other PARTY [IES] shall be shared between the PARTIES, the terms and conditions of which shall be the subject matter of a separate agreement between the PARTIES.

5.4 The PARTIES shall not assign any rights and obligations to any third PARTIES without written consent of the other party.

Article 6. Implementation

6.1 The PARTIES agree to constitute an Advisory Committee as follows:

6.2 Based on the education, training and research requirements of students and staff, the advisory committee shall, in consultation with the faculty and scientists, decide on topics and the mode of cooperation for each of the academic years during the tenure of this cooperation.

6.3 The convener and co-convener shall be the contact persons for all the cooperation and other related issues identified in this understanding.

Article 7. Finance

7.1 Each PARTY shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this agreement. Neither PARTY shall make a claim against the other PARTY for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon in writing between the PARTIES.

Article 8. General Provisions

8.1 Research instrumentation, infrastructure and library facilities available at the PARTIES work place(s) shall be made available to the scientists, faculty, research scholars and students of the PARTIES.

8.2 The PARTIES shall not use any of the confidential information which is required to be held in confidence for any purpose other than performance of their obligations under this understanding.

8.3 The implementation of the areas and forms of cooperation identified under Articles 2 and 3 shall be subject to the availability and convenience of research students, faculties and infrastructure facilities available at the PARTIES work places.

8.4 The PARTY organizing an item of work shall have the nodal responsibility for mobilizing resources and the conduct of such works.

8.5 There shall be exchange visits by faculty members for academic and research purposes.

8.6 There shall be exchanges of students between both the parties with the convenience of both the parties so that students can be benefitted by the good teachers of both PARTIES.

8.7 All questions related to this understanding arising during its term shall be settled by the PARTIES by mutual agreement. In case of any disagreement a retired District Judge shall be appointed and remuneration of whom shall be paid jointly.

8.8 Nothing in this understanding is intended to affect other cooperation or collaboration between the PARTIES.

8.9 All the collaboration activities pursuant to this agreement shall be conducted in accordance with the laws and regulations governing SGC and HCC.

Article 9. Entry into Effect and Termination

9.1 Our Memorandum of Understanding had been signed earlier for a duration of 03.01.2020 - 03.02.2024. As per our prior agreement we jointly decide to continue our collaboration which has been mutually beneficial and fruitful to both the Institutions, Hence we wish to extend the validity of the existing MoU. This would facilitate further mutual growth and research collaborations between the two Institutions.

9.2 This MOU shall be effective for a period of **Five Years** henceforth, and shall be automatically renewed thereafter for another five years which will be valid 3rd February, 2034 unless a written notice to terminate or amend this agreement is given to the other PARTY six months in advance.

9.3 It is expressly agreed that neither party shall be liable for damages that they might cause each other as a result of a forceful suspension of a collaboration program. Causes for forceful suspension must be explicitly set forth in the action plans.

9.4 All joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of this agreement may be continued until their completion under the terms of this understanding.

Article 10. Amendments

10.1 This MoU represents the entire understanding between the PARTIES and supersedes any and all understandings either oral or written hither-to with respect to the subject matter of this understanding.

10.2 No amendment or modification of the MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the PARTIES and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of the MoU. The modifications/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed unless otherwise agreed to.

Article 11. Assignment

11.1 This MoU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each PARTY and hence neither PARTY shall transfer or assign this agreement or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

Article 12. Conflict Resolution

12.1 Any dispute resulting from the interpretation or application of this Agreement shall be settled through direct negotiation and common agreement by the persons delegated to such end by each Institution. Either party may propose to the other a modification of the Agreement at any time in writing.

Article 13. Non-exclusivity

13.1 The relationship of the PARTIES under this understanding shall be non-exclusive and both PARTIES are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind. This MoU has been executed in two originals, one of which has been retained by SGC and the other by HCC
