ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college premises. If anybody found indulged in such kind of activities, strict action will be taken irrespective of the extent. Supreme Court of India has banned ragging. In order to prevent such activity in campus, Anti Ragging committees have been developed and brought into operation by the Principal/College Administration. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited within the premises of the college/department/classroom as well as on transport. Any individual or group of individuals who indulge in an act or practice of ragging constitutes gross indiscipline and such individual/ groups shall be dealt with as per the ordinance. This includes individual or collective acts or practices that involve physical assault or threat or use of physical force, which violate the status, dignity, and honour of any student.

Students shall not:

- Violate the status, dignity and honour of girl students.
- Violate the status, dignity and honour of SC and ST students.
- Expose students to ridicule and contempt thereby affect their self-esteem.
- Entail verbal abuse and aggression indecent gestures and obscene behaviour.
- The Principal / the Anti ragging committee shall take immediate action on any information of the occurrence of ragging.

Actions to be taken against students for indulging and abetting in Ragging in Holy Cross College:

The raggers will invite appropriate punishment which may include expulsion from the institution or classes for a defined period of time or fine with a public apology.

The other punishment shall be:

- Withholding scholarship or other benefits
- Debarring from representation in events
- Debarring from examinations
- Any other punishments as per the law of the land
