

# ADDENDUM TO STRATEGIC PLAN 2023-2024

Addendum to strengthen the strategic plan of Holy Cross College in relation to AICTE (All India Council for Technical Education) and ITEP (Integrated Teacher Education Programme).

## **1. AICTE Guidelines Implementation**

- **Technical Education and Modernization:** Develop technical courses aligned with AICTE guidelines such as BBA, MBA, AI, machine learning, and data analytics to attract students interested in technical fields.
- **Accreditation and Standardization:** Ensure all engineering, management, and technical programs meet AICTE accreditation standards. Focus on curriculum updates as recommended by AICTE, including technical skill-building and soft skills.
- **Industry-Institute Collaboration:** Build stronger relationships with industries for student internships, research partnerships, and placements in line with AICTE's goals of bridging education and industry.

## **2. Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP)**

- **Teacher Education Enhancement:** Develop a specialized teacher education program in line with ITEP that provides a four-year integrated degree covering B.Ed. and related subjects. Pedagogical Training: Incorporate courses on modern teaching techniques, child development, and educational psychology.
- **Field Work and Practice:** Ensure practical teaching experience through regular fieldwork and internships, aligning with ITEP's emphasis on hands-on experience in schools.

Additional Areas to Consider:

- **Curriculum Modernization:** Continue modernizing the curriculum by incorporating feedback from NAAC, AICTE, and stakeholders, keeping pace with the latest educational trends and technology, the college may introduce Bridge courses/Add-on Courses/Non-Credit Certificate courses.
- **Sustainability and Value-Based Education:** Emphasize environmental studies and sustainable development in the curriculum to align with global education goals.

- Entrepreneurship and Innovation Hubs: Create incubation centres for start-ups and entrepreneurial training, providing a platform for students to work on innovative projects and business ideas.

### **3. Global Collaborations and Exchange Programs**

- International Partnerships: Establish partnerships with international universities for student and faculty exchange programs, research collaborations, and joint degree programs to enhance global exposure.
- Cultural Exchange: Encourage student and faculty participation in global academic and cultural exchange programs, contributing to a more diverse learning environment.

- Sustainability Projects: Initiate community-based sustainability projects such as waste management and renewable energy awareness in nearby localities.

- Digital Marketing Strategy: Enhance the institution's online presence through effective digital marketing, social media engagement, and a robust website to attract national and international students.
- Brand Positioning: Work on brand positioning by highlighting the college's unique offerings such as integrated programs, research initiatives, and industry partnerships.
