# Report on Add-On Course on "Mushroom Biology and Farming" (Second Batch)

Course Duration: Three months (June, 2024 to September, 2024)

Department of Botany, Holy Cross College, Agartala, successfully concluded its second batch of the Add-on Course in Mushroom Cultivation. This three-month course from June, 2024 to September, 2024, was conducted under the supervision of Rahul Debnath, a Senior Research Scholar from the Botany Department of Tripura University, following an established MoU between the two institutions. Seven students enrolled in the second batch of this course. The course aimed to provide practical knowledge and hands-on experience in mushroom cultivation to seven enrolled students.

Course Structure: The course was meticulously designed to cover every aspect of mushroom cultivation, from spawn culture to the final production stages. It offered a balanced mix of theoretical learning and practical exposure, including laboratory work, field visits, and technical skill development. The syllabus was spread over three months, giving students ample time to master the techniques necessary for successful mushroom farming.

Day 1: Inaugural Lecture and Laboratory Tour The inaugural day began with a short introduction by Rahul Debnath. Seven students were enrolled to the course. All of them were present on the first Day. Some more students also attended the inaugural day accompanied by Dr. Sudipta Sinha, Assistant Professor of Department of Botany, Holy Cross College, Agartala. The course commenced with an extensive lecture which provided a comprehensive overview of mushroom cultivation. The lecture covered key topics, such as:

- > The life cycle and biology of fungi.
- > Types of edible and medicinal mushrooms.
- > The economic potential of mushroom farming.
- Techniques for spawn production and mushroom culture.

The students were actively engaged in discussions, asking questions and clarifying doubts. Following the lecture, the students were given a guided tour of the college's laboratory and culture room. During the tour, they were introduced to the scientific equipment necessary for mushroom cultivation, including:

- > Laminar airflow chambers.
- > Autoclaves for sterilization.
- Incubators for growing cultures.
- Microscopes for observing fungal structures.

The demonstration helped the students understand the crucial role of maintaining sterile conditions and precise temperature control for successful mushroom cultivation.

Weeks 1—4: Practical Sessions on Spawn and Mushroom Culture In the following classes, the focus shifted to the practical application of the theoretical knowledge gained during the first day. Over the course of several weeks, students were trained in the critical stages of spawn culture, including:

- > Tissue culture techniques to isolate mycelium.
- Preparation of culture media and sterilization procedures.
- Transferring mycelium to sterile grain substrates.

Students were given hands-on experience in creating and maintaining spawn cultures, with the research scholar from Tripura University closely observing their progress. Each student practiced inoculation techniques and worked on maintaining sterile conditions in the laboratory, which are essential to preventing contamination.

Weeks 5–8: Mushroom Culture and Field Visit As the course progressed, students transitioned from spawn preparation to mushroom culture techniques. They were introduced to different substrates used for mushroom cultivation, with a particular emphasis on paddy straw, which is locally available and commonly used in mushroom farming.

During this phase, students also visited a mushroom cultivation site to observe mushroom growth in natural conditions. This field visit provided valuable real-world insights into large-scale mushroom farming, helping the students understand how laboratory practices translate to outdoor settings. They observed how environmental factors such as humidity, temperature, and substrate management influence the growth of mushrooms.

Weeks 9-12: Substrate Preparation, Inoculation, and Final Test In the final phase of the course, students focused on preparing paddy straw as a substrate for mushroom inoculation. This included:

- Cutting, soaking, and sterilizing the paddy straw.
- Inoculating the straw with spawn using the techniques they had learned in the laboratory.
- Setting up the substrates in a controlled environment for mushroom fruiting.

The students applied the skills they had acquired over the past months, closely monitoring their projects to ensure successful mushroom growth. The research scholar provided guidance throughout the process, ensuring the students adhered to best practices in substrate preparation and inoculation.

The course concluded with a small test to evaluate the students' understanding and practical application of mushroom cultivation techniques. The assessment covered both theoretical aspects, such as fungal biology and economic applications, as well as practical skills, such as spawn preparation and substrate inoculation.
