
- Hand gloves (10 nos.)

We sincerely believe that your support and encouragement will enable us to make this event both educational and meaningful for the students while upholding the values of our institution.



Educational Visit to Science City, Agartala: "Exploring the Intersection of Science and  
History"

**REPORT**

On Wednesday, 11th December 2024, the 1st Semester Under-graduate History Major batch of Holy Cross College, Agartala, undertook an enriching educational visit to **Science City**, Agartala, under the theme "*Exploring the Intersection of Science and History*." This visit, meticulously planned as part of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 objectives, aimed to foster multidisciplinary learning and expand students' perspectives by integrating science and historical understanding. A cohort of 24 **students** was accompanied by **four (4) faculty members**, including the Assistant Head of the Department of History, making this an engaging and well-supervised academic activity.

Science City, a renowned institution in Agartala, is celebrated not only for its pioneering efforts in promoting scientific literacy but also for preserving and showcasing elements of Tripura's rich historical and cultural heritage. This blend of science and history provided an ideal platform to bridge disciplines and offer students practical insights into how scientific developments influence historical narratives and vice versa. The visit aligned with the educational philosophy of the NEP, which encourages critical thinking and the breaking down of traditional academic silos.

The group arrived at Science City at 02:00 PM, where they were received by the officials and staff. The visit began with a **guided tour of the science exhibits**, covering interactive modules that ranged from environmental science, space exploration, and physics demonstrations to advanced technologies such as artificial intelligence and renewable energy solutions. These exhibits helped the students appreciate the transformative role of science across centuries, fostering discussions on technological progression from antiquity to modernity.

Next, the focus shifted to the history-centric areas of Science City, particularly the exhibit on *India's Historical Legacy and Scientific Innovations*. This section illuminated how India had embraced early forms of technology and scientific application, such as irrigation systems and architectural marvels. Students engaged in critical dialogues about how these innovations not only shaped India's history but also contributed to broader patterns of historical evolution in the Asian continent.

The educational visit concluded with reflections and feedback, both oral and written. Many students expressed how the integration of science into the understanding of history had deepened their academic interests and encouraged interdisciplinary thinking. One student remarked that the visit "highlighted how science and history are not separate realms but interconnected dimensions of human civilization." Similarly, faculty members shared that the visit aligned well with the NEP's goals of holistic, student-centered education and interdisciplinary curriculum design.

In summary, the **educational visit to Science City, Agartala**, under the theme "*Exploring the Intersection of Science and History*," served as an exemplary academic endeavour that broadened horizons and instilled a renewed appreciation for learning among the 1st Semester History Major batch.
