REPORT ON FIELD TRIP OF ZOOLOGY DEPARTMENT FOR 5th SEMESTER (MAJOR) GROUP TO TEPANIA ECO-PARK AND DASHPARA BIOVILLAGE

On 19th November 2022 (Saturday), Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College, Agartala organized one field visit for 5th semester (Major) students. Total 28 students along with 3 faculty members visited this trip. This field visit was divided into 2 phases.

In the first phase, students visited Daspara Bio Village, which was funded under BEUP scheme, 10-CharilamA/C(Brajapur). This is the first Bio-village in the country. There students observed all the facilities which benefitted around 54 families. Facilities such as Elective gadgets, cultivation of fish finger lings, Mushrooms, puffed rice machine, fish cultivation etc. Along with other facilities, they talked with some of the villagers about other facilities and how these facilities uplifted their lifestyles. Students along with faculty members were happy after communicating with them and students also felt excited after visiting this place for the first time.

In the second phase, they visited Tepania Eco-park which is in Radhakishorepur, Tripura. The amazing environment under scorching sun really boosted the students to rejuvenate themselves in a new way. Mentors divided students into various groups for capturing photos of various species. On the spot study of the live specimens were done by the students. The various zoological specimens observed were also listed by the students. They studied the nesting pattern of various bird species. Students besides their work, enjoyed extensively. Thus this trip was not only finished as a part of study tour but also flavoured various mixtures of emotions not only among students but also among faculties too.
