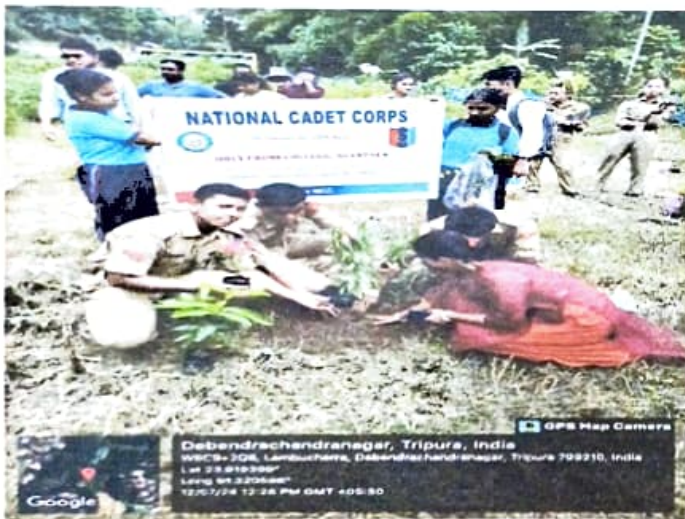

College Biotech Club of Zoology Department in collaboration with the Eco Nature Club and the NSS unit of Holy Cross, Agartala, organized a plantation drive in the Butterfly Park of HCC Campus on 12th July 2024. The main aim of the plantation drive was to provide suitable host plants and nectar plants for the butterfly species available in the park. Also, July is the month of Vanamahotsava. The ample rain and the climatic condition of July are most suitable for the germination of seeds and the growth of new plant saplings. Plants are gifts of nature. They help to clean adding more oxygen and taking in carbon di oxide of air. Plants also reduce soil erosion and combat climate changes. Green space also improves the mental wellbeing. Keeping these in view, the plantation drive was organized in which 24 students who are also active members College Biotech Club, members of Eco & Nature Club, NCC cadets along with the PI. and Co PI. of the Biotech Club Project, Dr. Parichita Ray Choudhury and Dr. Rumki Nath Sen and other faculty members of Zoology Department Dr. Subhalaxmi Bhattacharjee, Piyashi Das, faculty members concerned with Eco & Nature Club such as Dr. Debasree Lodh, Dr. Somnath Kar, Dr. Sushmita Saha, Dr. Sudipta Sinha and Mrs. Sangita Chakraborty of NCC Unit participated in the plantation program. About 76 plant saplings were procured under College Biotech Club Project which is sponsored by Directorate of Biotechnology, Govt. for the plantation program. These plants are mostly preferred by the butterfly species and comprised of *Lantena camera*, *Ixora*, different citrus plants, *Primula vulgaris*, *Duranta repens*, *Lawsonia inermis*, *Spondias mombin* etc. which were distributed among the students and the faculty members of HCC for plantation. Some students also brought plant saplings from their home for the plantation drive. The students dispersed themselves in small groups in the Holy Cross Butterfly Park and planted the plant saplings in different areas of the park. With the active cooperation and participation of the students and the faculty members of Holy Cross College the plantation drive was successfully carried out.
