Report on Educational Trip to Jampui Hill of Tripura

11th to 13th December 2024

Department of Political Science

Holy Cross College, Agartala

The department of Political Science had organized a short educational trip to Jampui Hill of Tripura on 11th December to 13th December 2024. The faculties of the department namely Dr. Mainul Islam, Dr. Sharmistha Rakshit, Dr. Rajeshree Debbarma, Ms. Mylodee Devi & Mr. Abhijit Dey including 13 students of 5th semester 2022-2025 batch were involved in this educational excursion. The main purpose of this trip was to conduct research survey on the challenges faced by the local inhabitants of the particular community through a structured questionnaire with whose aid the primary information had been collected by the students and faculties as well for in-depth study. It primarily tried to explore the life style in respect to socio-economic and political status of the native people. Interestingly the students got the opportunity to visit one of the most important event called Promo Fest 3rd event of Tripura Tourism which was held at Vanghmun field of Jampui Hill of Tripura on 11/12/2024 at 7.p.m where students got to explore the rich culture of Tripura.







The 12th December i.e, second day of the educational trip started with full bright sunshine whereas other parts of Tripura experienced foggy weather on the particular day, followed by heavy breakfast heading towards a local market, Betlingchhip which is situated at 29km distance from Phuldungsei, MJ Homestay. The students were given a set of questionnaires to collect the information from the traders by Dr. Sharmistha Rakshit, similarly some students were instructed and guided by Dr. Rajeshree Debbarma to gather the information from women traders in regard to their development and socio-economic status. Furthermore, Dr. Mainul Islam had conducted a survey with the President of Mizo Students Organization, known as Mizo Zirlai Pawl (MZO) Jampui Branch of Tripura, thus collected first-hand authentic information acquiring reliable sources about the students organization. Thereafter, the students were engaged in shopping the local products exported from Burma, some burmese product widely known as rice cake, pickles, plums, chinese noddles, pork sausages and many more. Henceforth, in the evening there was a bonfire camp at 8.pm arranged by the manager of MJ Homestay on special request by the faculties to entertain the students with music and dance, subsequently it was a very warm experience connecting and building strong relationship between students and teachers of the department, thereafter which followed by last dinner at MJ Homestay.

The last day of the educational trip on 13th of December 2024 began with a morning ramp headed by Mr. Abhijit Dey and Myleodee Devi, inhaling the fresh air along with the students to view the sunrise from the highest peak of Tripura popularly known as Betlingchhip. The students and the faculties were so excited to visit on foot enthusiastically rising up at 4.30.am early morning to witness the beautiful scene of the sunrise as the distance from the homestay is approximately 1km, thereby it was convenient from all aspects. Eventually, it was a wonderful experience enriching the two cultures surrounded with Mizo and Reang tribe particularly their livelihood. Moreover, as the students and faculties were mainly from plain area while experiencing a typical life standard comparatively with the lifestyle of the hilly area in regard to their lifestyle and thus could realize the hindrances

laced by the local inhabitants of Jampui Hill of Tripura. However, this short educational trip had impacted in our life with full of knowledge experiencing and unforgettable memories specially the cleanest village of the state, Tripura i.e, Vanghmun, Jampui Hill, where it reflects the culture meets the nature. Finally, coming to an end of this trip while returning, the department had initiated to dropped inn a beautiful Jampui Hill park with a written placard I LOVE JAMPUI HILL, indeed this excursion had enriched us with hands on learning and understanding the culture has no end in one specific area, thus it was a successful trip.
