Report on plant sapling distribution, plantation program and interactive session at Sipai Para Village to promote butterfly garden, Organized by Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College, Agartala on 29<sup>th</sup> May 2024 in collaboration with College Biotech Club, sponsored by Directorate of Biotechnology, Govt. of Tripura.

Butterfly gardens not only add aesthetic value to the environment, it also reduces habitat fragmentation and degradation, thus offering a holistic growth of the ecosystem. Butterfly being an excellent pollinators, such gardens are also helpful for the farmers. Keeping this in view, Department of Zoology of Holy Cross College, Agartala organized a plant sapling distribution, plantation program and interactive session at Sipai Para Village to promote butterfly garden among the villagers. This outreach program was conducted in Sipai Para Village as a part of the awareness program on the significance of butterfly gardens at house hold levels as a part of the College Biotech Club Project, titled, Establishment of Butterfly Park in Holy Cross College Campus with a view of conservation of sustainable utilization of biodiversity of the area.'

The program was organized near the Anganwari Centre and the Panchayet office of the Sipai Para Village on 29<sup>th</sup> May at 12 pm. About 50 plant saplings were procured from the Forest Department, Govt. of Tripura for the program. A total of thirty students of Zoology Department who are also the members of College Biotech Club actively participated in the program. They were guided by Dr. Parichita Ray Choudhury and Dr. Rumki Nath Sen, the P.I. & the Co PI., College Biotech Club Project respectively as well the other members of Zoology Department of Holy Cross College, Agartala. The students distributed 50 plant saplings, encouraged the villagers for planting them. They also interacted with the villagers and made them aware of the ecological role of butterflies and the importance of having butterfly gardens around their kitchen garden, home and agricultural lands. The plant saplings procured for the program comprised of the species which are preferred by the local butterfly species as their host plants and nectar plants. After the interactive session, both the villagers and the students were provided with refreshments.
