REPORT ON FIELD TRIP BY STUDENTS OF THIRD SEMESTER (GENERAL) GROUP OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY

A field trip was carried out on 16th Nov, 2023 (11.00 am to 02.00pm) by the students of 3rd semester Zoology General of Holy Cross College, Agartala, to study the terrestrial fauna of a location within Sipaipara Village, Debendrachandranagar, West Tripura. The location was about 1.02 km from the College area. The studied area mainly comprised of *Hevea brasiliensis*, *Mangifera indica*, *Ficus elastica* and *Bambusa* sp.

To get a general overview of the inhabiting terrestrial fauna, the students of the group made a thorough observation of the locality close to the mixed forest area.

The overall observations revealed that the studied area was populated with about 20 different species. They belonged to the phylum Arthropoda, Annelida. Ample number of insect species were photographed. Earthworms like *Metaphire houlletti* were found. Common leech (*Hirudinea* sp) was observed as well. There were casts of earthworms as well.

Butterfly is an indicator species and represent the ample diversity of the area. Many different types of butterflies were encountered which indicates the area is very rich in biodiversity. Specimens like *Junonia atlites*, *Ixias pyrene*, *Acytolepis puspa* were photographed. Dragonflies were observed as well.

The juvenile minds of the department were encouraged enough by this short trip to look into their neighbourhood, list and take care of their local fauna.

Total number of students participating in the trip was 41. The group was accompanied by Dr. Subhalaxmi Bhattacharjee, Asst. Professor and Dr. Anamika Bhowmik, Asst. Professor, Dept. of Zoology. The Laboratory Assistant of the Department, Miss Jeni Debbarma also accompanied the group.


