#### **NATIONAL DEWORMING CAMPAIGN**

Venue: Holy Cross College, Agartala

Soil-transmitted helminths (STH) are India's significant public health concern. Around 22 crore Indian children aged 1-14 are estimated to be at risk of worm infections. Worms in children interfere with nutrient uptake and can contribute to anemia, malnourishment, and impaired mental and physical development. Tripura, with 60% worm prevalence, will conduct both rounds as per the Government of India and WHO guidelines. The objective of National deworming day (NDD) is to deworm all the children and teenagers between the ages of 1-19 years through the platform of Anganwadi centers, schools and colleges in order to improve their overall health, nutritional status, access to education and quality of life. As a part of present initiative, Department of Human Physiology, Holy Cross College, Agartala had also organized 'National Deworming Campaign' under the banner of "Mukhyamantri Sushtho Shaishob Sustho Kaishore Abhiyan 5.0 (MSSSKA 5.0)" on 9th February 2024. The faculty members of Human Physiology Department provide crucial information about different health complications of worms and thereafter distributed medicines among the students. The medicines are 'Albendazole' and 'Iron and Folic acid tablets,' which were provided by Mohanpur PHC. Students were also advised about the dosage of taking these medicines as per Mohanpur PHC's guidelines. The medicines are distributed to 200 students in total: out of them 105 girls and 95 boys under 19 years of age.


