During the session, the students spoke about the revolutionary works of renowned personalities such as Dr. Birbal Sahni, the father of Indian paleobotany; Janaki Ammal, known for her significant contributions to plant cytogenetics and biodiversity conservation; and M.S. Swaminathan, the architect of the Green Revolution in India. Through their presentations, students explored how the dedication and innovative work of such renowned scientists have left a lasting impact on scientific and agricultural development in India.

Though the event was kept simple, it successfully created a meaningful opportunity for students to recognize and reflect upon the extraordinary contributions of Indian botanists. This exercise not only deepened their appreciation of botanical science but also highlighted how these historical achievements continue to influence modern research and practices.


