A People's Biodiversity Register is a document that contains comprehensive information about the biodiversity in a specific area. It includes details about the flora, fauna, traditional knowledge, and practices related to biodiversity conservation. By compiling this information, the PBR helps in understanding and managing the local biodiversity effectively. The PBR is an important tool for documenting and conserving biodiversity at the local level. Creating awareness about biodiversity conservation and documenting the local flora and fauna through the PBR is a significant step towards protecting and preserving the rich natural heritage. It is an excellent initiative that promotes environmental education, research, and community involvement in safeguarding biodiversity for future generations.

Holy Cross College participated in a nationwide initiative of PBR up-gradation and verification in collaboration with the Tripura Biodiversity Board (TBB) and the National Biodiversity Board (NBA) regarding the celebration of International Day for Biological Diversity (IDB) on May 22, 2023, in conjunction with Mission LiFE & Environment Day celebrated on June 5, 2023. A total of 29 students of Holy Cross College were involved in the preparation of the PBRs of 14 Gram Panchayats (GPs) and Village Councils (VCs) under the guidance of Dr Somnath Kar, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany, HCC between 23rd May 2023 to 4th June 2023





Sir,

This is to inform you that this year the National event of International Day for Biological Diversity (IDB) will be celebrated in Mumbai, Maharashtra. Subsequent to the event, the Hon'ble MEFCC will be launching a nationwide initiative of PBR updation cum verification on 23rd May, 2023 from the state of Goa. In this process,the services of graduate and post graduate students of the Botany/Zoology/Biology disciplines across the country will be drawn to participate in the programme starting from 23rd May to 4th June 2023. During the period, more than 10,000 PBRs are to be updated by the University/College students studying Botany/Zoology/Biology courses in all the States and Union Territories. Each State/UTBCs will be given a specific number of PBRs to be updated and verified for the purpose (Annexure A). The participating students will be awarded with a certificate of participation in this National excercise.

The following Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) may be followed for lauching this excercise.

- 1. Selection of students of Botany/Zoology/Biology disciplines and conducting half day capacity building for them to carry out the task.
- 2. Involvement of the Technical Support Group (TSG) to support their participation in the programme.
- 3. Uploading one or two pictures of photographic evidence of the activity on the website (mandatory) about visit to each BMC for updation & verification of PBR should be done. The details about the website and the procedure of uploading will be informed shortly.
- 4. Writing the name and putting a signature of the student on the PBR who visits the village is mandatory

5. Record the entire process of launching, updating cum verification of PBRs through photodocumentation and share highlight of the events in social media.

Further, SBB may encourage BMCs to celebrate IDB in conjunction with action points of Mission LiFE. A couple of the activities that can be taken up by the SBBs and BMCs are given as under:

State/UTBC level

At State level, at least a half day programme with selected speakers propagating IDB 2023 & Mission LiFE can be organized by SBB. Further, the States/UTs may highlight any or a few of the following actionable points of Mission LiFE during the celebration of IDB 2023.

- 1. Participate in and mobilize participation for a clean-up drives of cities and water bodies
- 2. Promote inclusion of millets in diets.
- 3. Prefer locally available seasonal foods
- 4. Encourage use of Millets in food and indigenous herbs and medicinal plants for nutritional well being
- 5. Prefer consuming natural or organic products
- 6. Start biodiversity conservation at Community Level
- 7. Plant medicinal plants life "Neem, Tulsi, Giloi, Mint, Curry leaves, Aswaganda *etc.,* with in household premises
- 8. Practice natural/ organic farming
- 9. Plant trees to reduce the impact of pollution
- 10. Initiate and / or join green clubs in residential area/school/office.

BMC Level

- 1. Medicinal plants may be distributed freely
- 2. Participate in and mobilize participation for a clean-up drives in villages and water bodies
- 3. Importance of consuming natural or organic products and millets will be highlighted.
- 4. The villagers contributing to planting and protecting trees and clean environment will be felicitated.

Further necessary directions will be given in due course. Your cooperation and active participation in this regard is highly solicited.
