A National Level Webinar was conducted by the Department of Commerce on 29th July 2020 from 10:15am till 12:15pm on the theme "Impact on International Trade and Commerce Post COVID-19". The resource persons for the webinar was **Dr. C. J. Thomas**, Former Dy. Director ICSSR-NERC; **Dr. G. Ram Datta**, Professor & Head (MDP), Indian Institution Foreign Trade and **Mr. Biswajit Chakraborty**, Director, & Head, Northeast council, FICCI.

The aforesaid webinar was held on the Google Meet platform where good number of participants joined the webinar. There were 175 registered participants who joined the webinar from Assam, Rajasthan, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Telangana, West Bengal, Punjab, Mizoram, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, Jammu & Kashmir and Tripura making it truly a national level. 

Report on the National Webinar


