Blessed Basil Moreau (1799-1873)

Basil Moreau the founder of the community of Holy Cross was born in Laigne-en-Belin, a town in Le Mans, France on February 11, 1799. As a priest of the diocese of Le Mans and seminary professor, he established the Association of Holy Cross consisting of two societies one of men (brothers and priests) and the other of women, both having as principal ministries, the education of youth. He was raised to the status of Blessed by the Church on September 15, 2007 for living heroic virtues in life. Through the leadership of Blessed Basil Moreau Holy Cross Contributed mightily for the building up of France that was devastated by the Revolution.

The men and women of Holy Cross maintain educational institutions as well as important social and pastoral ministries in North and South America, Africa and Asia. Holy Cross has a strong presence in Northeast India since 1853, the then undivided India. Holy Cross Universities, Colleges and Schools across the world are considered as excellent institutions of learning. Blessed Basil Moreau was an educator with very

definite ideas about teaching and learning and about curriculum in terms of both content and methodology. "I Have always been convinced That the first duty of every teachers is to produce good human beings; society has a greater need for people of values than it has for scholars. Knowledge itself does not bring about positive values, but positive values do Influence knowledge and put it to a good use." - wrote Bl. Moreau.

Blessed Basil Moreau defined education as something that would make persons better persons with positive human values. When a Holy Cross educator applies his knowledge to his own life situation, he/she tries to translate the founders words and Ideas to make better persons and better citizens of the society having positive human values.' In the words of Blessed Basil Moreau, "We shall always place education side by side with instruction: the mind will not be cultivated at the expense of the heart."

Courses Offered: The Program/course leading to a Post Graduate Degree is spread over two years and consists of four Semesters, each approximately of six months duration.

M.A (ENGLISH)

MA in English aims to widen the horizons of learning and research in literature, and other related aspects to accelerate the growing interest of the students who are in pursuit of larger avenues. The papers offered are as contemporarily relevant as possible and a conscious effort is made to ensure that theories are grounded in textual readings, wherever possible. The objective is to help them enhance and gain a nuanced understanding of their curriculum. Testing and evaluation patterns aim at fostering a culture of research rather than an examination-only driven system, which will enhance students' reading and creativity. In keeping with practical demands, ELT and a few other papers help to make the

MA in English extensively covers topics from English Literature which primarily focuses on poetry, prose, novel, drama, language and grammar. Considering the fact that literature itself is a vast subject, students are given the opportunity to select electives of their choice.

Literature, language and culture being the interdisciplinary areas of study are incorporated as essential parts and parcels of the MA English program. Hence, the program intends to provide multiple career prospects to the students of this program. Some of the conventional career options include editing, journalism, teaching, translation and writing.

Eligibility criteria for MA in English

Aspiring students should have a graduation degree in English from a recognized institution or should have studied English as a subject in their Undergraduate Degree program from a recognized institution.

A minimum of 55% marks in graduation level is required as a qualifying criteria and aspirants will also be required to appear for the entrance examinations to get selected to the MA in English program in the college. Selection of the candidates in this college will be based on marks secured in the final merit i.e. total marks secured in the graduation level and marks obtained in the entrance examinations.

M.A (Political Science)

M.A (Political Science) or Master of Arts in Political Science is a Post-Graduate program in Political Science. The Master of Arts in Political Science is a two years program and the course includes a comprehensive and thorough study of Political Science as a discipline at an advanced level. The Master of Arts in Political Science involves the study of the theory and practice of politics and the description and analysis of political systems and political behaviour.

The Master of Arts in Political Science also covers the study of both national and international political systems, historical and modern political systems, public administration, governmental policies and procedures, international relations, and public affairs. The study of this field includes topics such as Principles of Political Science, Indian Political System, Major Governments of the World, International Relations, etc. The Master of Arts course in Political Science provides widespread career scopes to the aspirants of Civil Services Examinations. The Program also enhances the ability to use established theories and concepts of social policy to analyse how social needs, problems, and policies are constructed and understood in various contexts; undertake investigations into social issues, involving the use of various skills to identify a problem and collect store, manage and manipulate data are also good for this course.

Eligibility criteria for MA in Political Science

Aspiring students should have a graduation degree in Political Science from a recognized institution or should have studied Political Science as a subject in their Undergraduate Degree program from a recognized institution.
