Initiative -1:

A weekly class routine was prepared in blended mode, where the 1st semester was having offline classes on three days in a week, that is on Monday, Wednesday and Friday and the 3rd and 5th-semester students were having their share of the weekly offline classes on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Accordingly, the 1st semester was having online classes on Tuesdays and Thursdays and the 3rd and 5th semesters were having online classes on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Initiative -2:

A format was created by the college administration to collect the vacation-related details, such as separate columns for the 1st and 2nd doses of the Covid vacation, along with the dates, which vacation is being taken by the employee, etc. to gather information on the status of fully vaccinated staff in the college. Students were also urged to get themselves fully vaccinated at the earliest. Automated sanitizers were installed at the main entrance of the main building of the college and a handwashing facility was also made available in front of the main gate of the college.

Initiative -3:

The third and fifth semesters examinations were being arranged in the college in the second half of February 2021, by fully adhering to the covid protocols such as maintenance of proper social distancing among two examinees and mandatory wearing of masks.

Initiative -4:

All the faculty members of the different departments of the college got shifted to the new 'Faculty Room' in the last week of January 2021.

Initiative -5:

All the departments of the college purchased a good number of books and new titles to enrich the college Library from the 2021 Agartala Book Fair.

Initiative -6:

Seven teams comprising all the faculty members were being created to specifically work on the seven criteria of the NAAC SSR. One FDP was also planed for all the faculties of the college to further enrich their understanding of the SSR preparation.

Initiative -7:

A Two Day State Level Workshop was organized by the collegeon March 12 and 13 2021 in offline/physical mode.
