Policy:

ADMISSION DETAILS

Course Offered	- Two Years Regular B.Ed. Course
Medium of Examination	- Bengali or English
Instruction	- Before filling in the application form please read carefully the instructions enclosed with application form.

Medium:

The medium of instruction is English. Candidates coming from vernacular medium schools are offered facilities to improve their skill in spoken English. However, a student may write B.Ed. Semester examinations in Bengali.

Admission Requirements:

The minimum eligibility norm for applying to B.Ed. Course is 50% marks in Graduation/Post Graduation degree/s. (5% relaxation for ST, SC, OBC, PWD Candidates as per NCTE Norms).

Documents Required:

Photocopies of following documents have to be attached with the application form.

- (a) All marks sheets and certificates from Madhyamik/Secondary onwards.
- (b) Honours candidates shall submit the marks sheets for the whole course (all the years including the Pass/Internal/Elective part of the course) and not only Honours marks sheet.
- (c) Madhyamik/Secondary Admit Card/Certificate for verification of age.
- (d) Citizenship Card/PRTC/PRC – compulsory.
- (e) Caste Certificate.
- (f) Migration Certificate, if applicable.
- (g) Copy of Tripura Central University registration– if applicable.
- (h) NOC from employer– if applicable.
- (i) Baptism certificate for Christian candidates and a letter from the Parish Priest.

SELECTION

The admission shall be made on the basis of merit prepared out of marks obtained from Madhyamik/Secondary onwards, Entrance Test & Interview.

Interview:

The applicants will have to go through a personal interview at the campus. To determine the applicant's command over English, attitude, aptitude, interest & personality expected of a teacher as well as the knowledge of the method subjects.

At the time of Interview:

All original mark sheets and other certificates from Madhyamik/Secondary onwards to be brought at the time of interview.

N.B: - The original migration certificate or Tripura Central University registration certificate should be submitted within 10 days of admission, failing which the candidature will be automatically cancelled.

PRE-ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The Completed application form along with the relevant certificates / mark sheets shall have to be submitted within the stipulated date as per the admission notification. Application forms and all correspondence should be addressed to:

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students have to put up minimum 90% attendance to appear in final B.Ed. Examinations as collegiate Students.
2. Students shall have to attend classes according to the timetable prescribed by the College.
3. Students are required to carry identity card within the campus.
4. Students are not permitted to leave the College without the prior permission.
5. A Student will not be allowed to continue in the college if it is found at any point of time that –
 - (a) Certificates of qualifying examination submitted by him / her are not genuine.
 - (b) He / She does not maintain discipline in the College.
 - (c) His / Her behavior is unbecoming of a student of the College.
6. Students have to appear at all the examinations conducted by the College.
7. Satisfactory performance in the college examinations is prerequisite for appearance at the University examinations.
8. If a student is found less than 90% attendance in the class or remain absent in the college without any intimation to the college authority for 30 days from the date of beginning of the classes, his/her admission will be automatically cancelled without any notice and waiting listed candidates may take admission as per the merit list position.
9. Admission fees once paid will not be returned under any circumstances.
10. Students are requested to be in touch with the college regarding Semester Marksheets and Pass out certificates. These information will be updated periodically in the College website.
11. Students are expected to collect their Marksheet and Pass out certificates, either in person or by an authorised person with in 60 days from the time of announcement in the website; beyond which a late fee of Rs. 50 (Rupees Fifty) per month will be charged. College does not take any responsibility of safe keeping the Marksheets or certificates beyond two years.

N.B. :-
